

A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses

31% of the students have rated the content of the syllabus as Excellent and 26% Very Good, indicating a high level of Satisfaction with the quality of the syllabus content. There are still 21% students who have rated the content as Good and 13% as Satisfactory, 9% students who have rated the content as Poor.




It seems like the certificate courses offered received generally positive feedback from students, with 21% rating them as Excellent and 19% rating them as Very Good. This indicates that a majority of students found the courses to be valuable and beneficial. 20% recorded as Good and 25% felt Satisfactory and 15% rated as Poor.

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


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29% of the students recorded as Excellent 26% rated as Very Good, 21% recorded as Good, 16% reported as Satisfactory and 8% recorded as Poor. Overall, it seems that the majority of students are satisfied with the extent of syllabi covered in the class.




30% of the students recorded as excellent about the online skill level of teachers, 28% reported as Very Good, 21% as Good, 15% recorded as Satisfactory and 6% felt as Poor. This feedback suggests that the majority of students perceive the teachers to possess strong online skills in teaching.

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


30% of the students reported the types of assignments given in class as Excellent, 31% felt Very Good, 22% of the students reported as Good, 10% registered as satisfactory and 7% as Poor.

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


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31% of the students rated the availability of study materials in online as Excellent, 39% reported as Very Good, 16% recorded as Good and 9% reported as Satisfactory and 5% as Poor. Positive feedback on the availability of study materials online is very good.




This feedback might be beneficial for the campus administration to assess the internet facilities. 28% of the students felt Excellent about the availability of internet facilities in the campus, 28% as Very Good, 12% rated as Good, 21% reported as Satisfactory and 11% as Poor.

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


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The support received from teachers during the pandemic period is observed to be good. 32% has reported it as Excellent, 24% as Very Good, 21% of the students reported as Good, 18% as Satisfactory and only 5% as Poor.



It seems like the satisfaction level of the mode of examination has generally received a positive feedback from students, with 36% rating them as Excellent and 25% rating them as Very Good.
