**Report**

Department of Commerce (Aided) arranged an Industrial Visit to V.V.V. & Sons Edible Oil Pvt. Ltd., Virudhunagar, (Idhayam) for III B.Com students on 17<sup>th</sup> March 2023 in order to:

- To make students gain practical knowledge on various industrial processes and operations.
- To increase the opportunities for internships, and placements for students.

Two faculty of the Commerce Department Dr.K. Chitra Chellam and Dr.S. Umamageswari and one non-teaching faculty Mrs.Ruckmani accompanied 44 students of III B.Com to the industry. Students and the faculty reached the factory at Villipathri in Virudhunagar at 10.00 a.m. Mobile phones were not permitted inside the factory for the students and faculty. Vaccination certificates of students and the faculty, their body temperature and heart rate were checked at the entry and each of them were given safety caps. The students and the faculty were taken to the Conference Hall of the factory where they were given a detailed presentation about the history of V.V.V. & Sons Edible Oil Pvt. Ltd, products offered by them, manufacturing process, raw materials required for manufacturing sesame oil, quality control, in-plant inspection, packing, usage of by-product, central godown, despatch of the finished product, and cultivational tips given to farmers for increasing the production of sesame. The presentation was given by Mr.Siva Murugan, Assistant Human Resource Manager of V.V.V. & Sons Edible Oil Pvt. Ltd,. This presentation session was followed by the physical visit of students and faculty to various units in the factory. 44 students were divided into 4 teams and each team was assisted by Production Officers who gave a detailed explanation about the processes and operations that take place in each of the following units:

- Sample cleaning and Drying Unit
- Hopper

- Pre-cleaning unit
- Fine cleaning Unit
- Seeds cleaning unit with 2 Classifier layers
- Crushing unit
- Oil cake unit and packing unit
- Pouch packing unit
- Bottling unit
- Packing unit &
- Central godown (method followed for despatching goods was explained)

After visiting all the above units, the students and the faculty were again taken to the Conference Hall where the Assistant HR continued his presentation about production, sales, and exports of Idhayam sesame oil and other products. He also explained certain marketing strategies followed by them to procure quality sesame seeds from farmers and to increase the sale of Idhayam products. The Assistant HR clarified the doubts of the students regarding cleaning process, automation, raw materials required per day for production, reasons for hike in the price of edible oils and what the marketing team do when there is slump in sales. The faculty had an interaction with the Assistant HR regarding student placements and internships at V.V.V. & Sons Edible Oil Pvt. Ltd for students belonging to both arts and science disciplines. The industrial visit was over by 2.15 p.m. and the students and the faculty reached the College at 5.00 p.m.

The industrial visit served as an experiential learning to both the students and the faculty. Meanwhile the faculty got a favourable response from the industry regarding placements and internships for students which would be beneficial for their career advancement.
