

The teacher feedback analysis on the relevance and usefulness of the courses prescribed shows a positive perception, with 58% of teachers rating it as Excellent and an additional 16% rating it as Very Good. Only 15% rated it as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 3% as Poor.




The analysis of teacher feedback regarding the freedom given to adopt new techniques shows that 60% of teachers rate it as Excellent, while 22% rate it as Good. While there's a positive perception overall, it's evident that there are a few areas where improvement could be made. Only 15% rated it as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 3% as Poor.


The teacher feedback on the encouragement to upgrade qualifications shows 55% of teachers rating it as Excellent and another 14% rating it as very Good. 22% rated it as Good, 6% as Satisfactory and 3% as Poor. 




