

The teacher feedback analysis on the relevance and usefulness of the courses prescribed shows a positive perception, with 54% of teachers rating it as Excellent and an additional 22% rating it as Very good. Only 13% rated it as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 3% as Poor




The analysis of teacher feedback regarding the freedom given to adopt new techniques shows that 59% of teachers rate it as Excellent, while 14% rate it as Good. 9% rated it as Good, 12% as Satisfactory and 6% as Poor While there's a positive perception overall, it's evident that there are a few areas where improvement could be made.



The teacher feedback on the encouragement to upgrade qualifications shows 54% of teachers rating it as excellent and another 17% rating it as very good. Only 19% rated it as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 2% as Poor. This indicates that a significant majority of the teaching staff perceives the college as supportive of innovation and open to the adoption of new teaching methodologies and strategies.



The teacher feedback on research culture in the college shows 63% of teachers rating it as Excellent and 16% rating it as very good. Only 12% rated it as Good, 6% as Satisfactory and 3% as Poor This indicates that a significant portion of the teaching staff perceives the college's efforts in this regard favorably, although there may still be room for improvement to ensure that all faculty members have adequate support for professional development.



Approximately 51% of teachers rate the availability of books in the library as Excellent, while 18% rate them as Very Good. Only 11% rated it as Good, 16% as Satisfactory and 2% as Poor. This suggests that a significant portion of the teaching staff views the resources positively.



Approximately 35% of teachers rate the ICT facilities as Excellent, while 19% rate them as Very Good,16% rated it as Good, 15% as Satisfactory and 15% as Poor. But there may also be areas where improvements could be made to enhance the overall experience.




