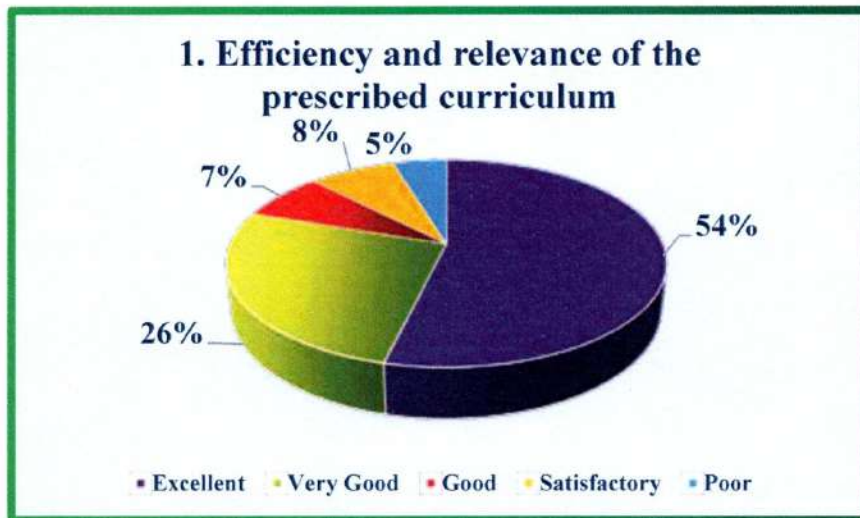

A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses



The teacher feedback analysis on the relevance and usefulness of the courses prescribed shows a positive perception, with 54% of teachers rating it as Excellent and an additional 26% rating it as Very Good. Only 7% rated it as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 5% as Poor.



The analysis of teacher feedback regarding the freedom given to adopt new techniques shows that 51% of teachers rate it as Excellent, while 15% rate it as Good. Only 20% rated it as Good, 10% as Satisfactory and 4% as Poor. While there's a positive perception overall, it's evident that there are a few areas where improvement could be made.

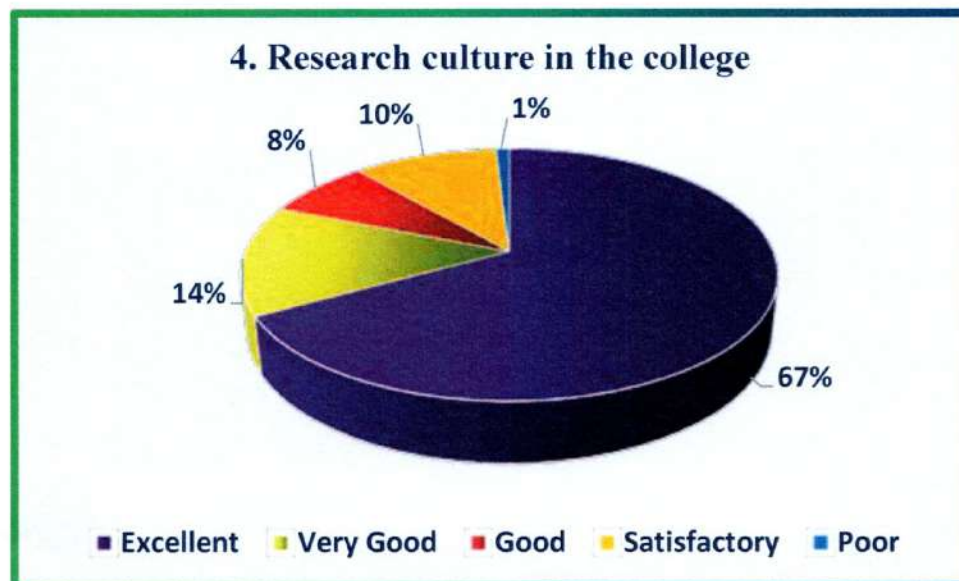

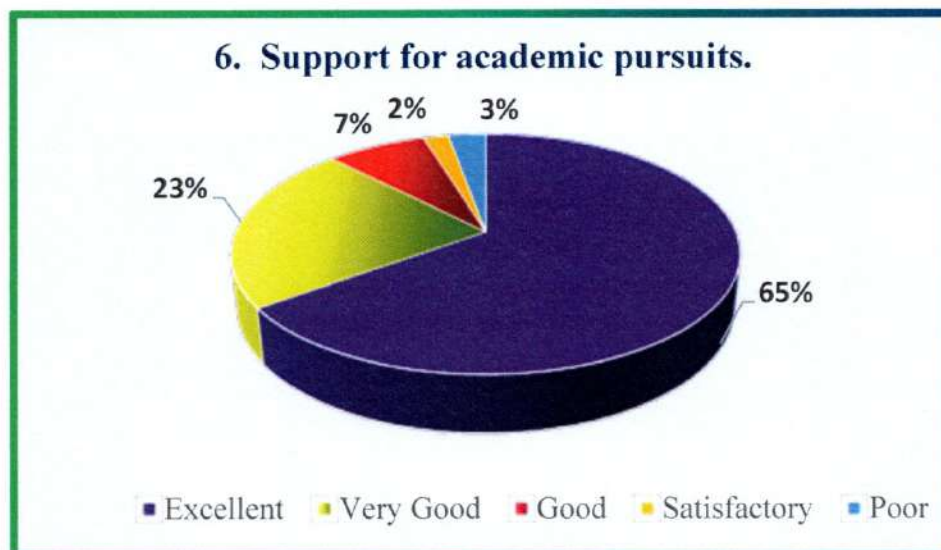

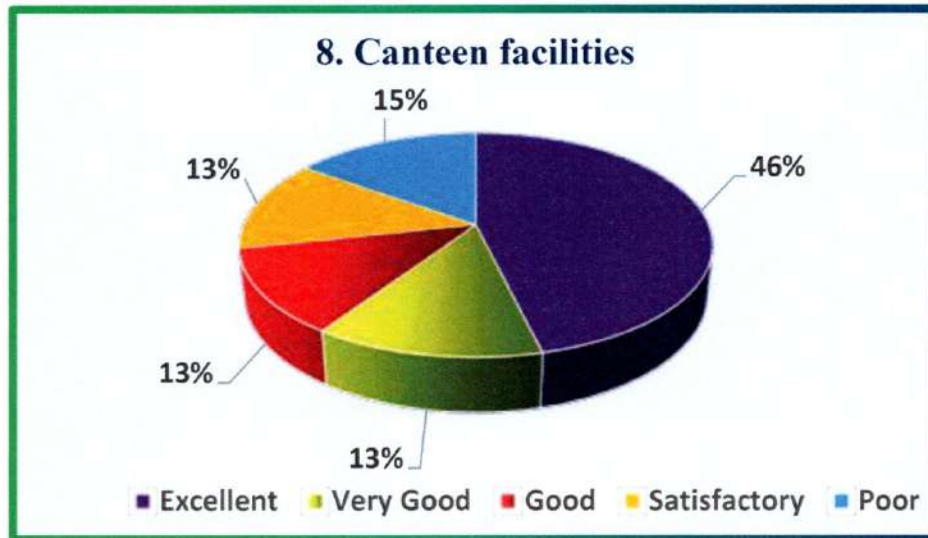

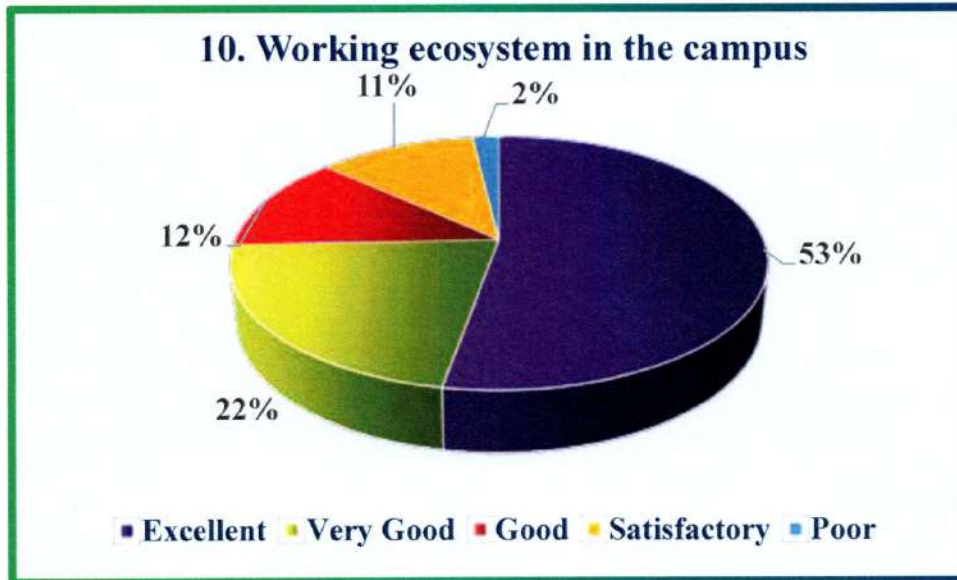
