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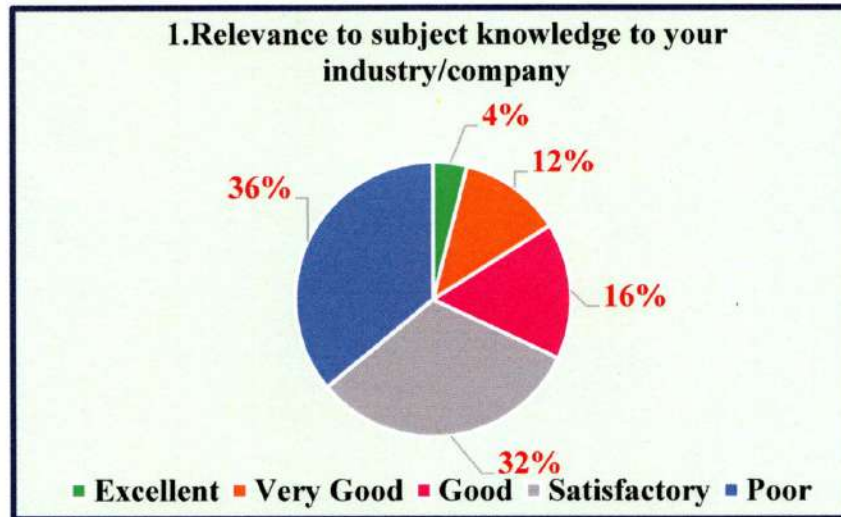

Analysis of Feedback from Employers

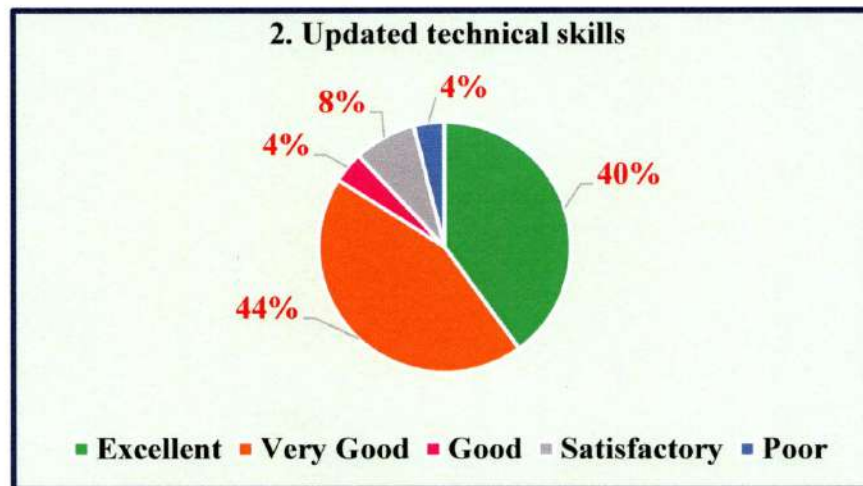

A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses



4% of the employers reported the subject knowledge is relevance to working company is Excellent, 12% felt Very Good, 16% reported as Good, 32% registered as Satisfactory and 36% as Poor which shows that majority of the employers are wish to focus more on practical skills related to industries.



40% of the employers rated as Excellent, 44% as Very Good, 4% as Good, 8% as Satisfactory and 4% as Poor which indicates that employers are happy with the technical skills offered through institution.

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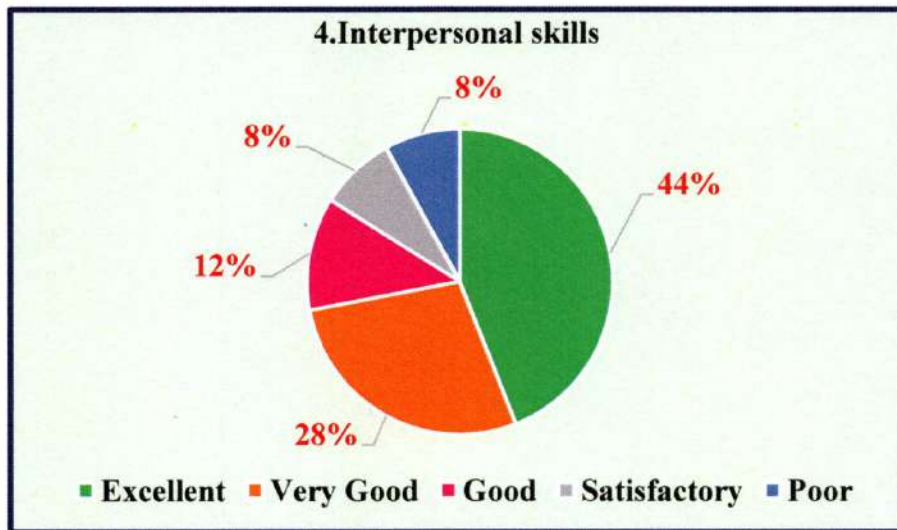

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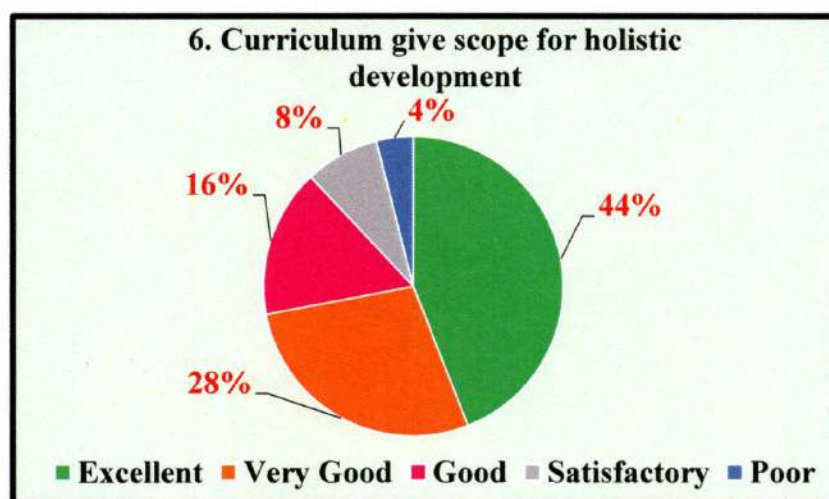
