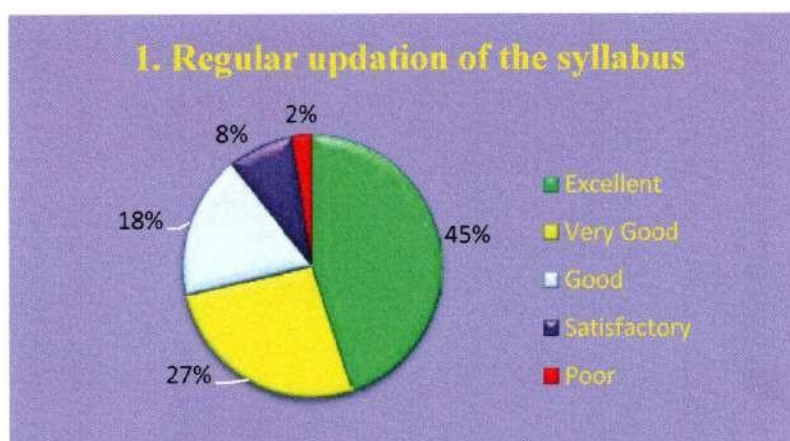

## **Analysis of Feedback from Students**

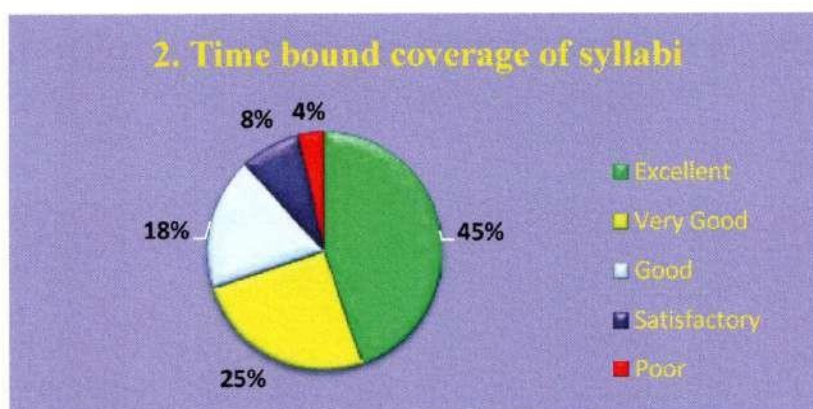

**A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses**



Feedback on the regular updating of the syllabus has been overwhelmingly positive. The majority of students 45% have rated the content of the syllabus as Excellent and 27% Very Good. There are still 18% students who have rated the content as Good and 8% as Satisfactory, 2% students who have rated the content as Poor.



Generally positive feedback received from students, with 45% rating them as Excellent and 25% rating them as Very Good. 18% recorded Good and 8% felt Satisfactory and 4% rated as Poor.

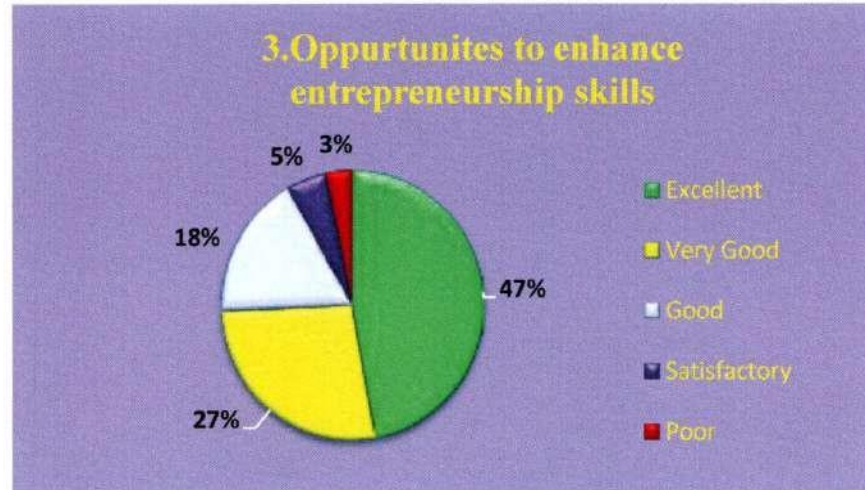




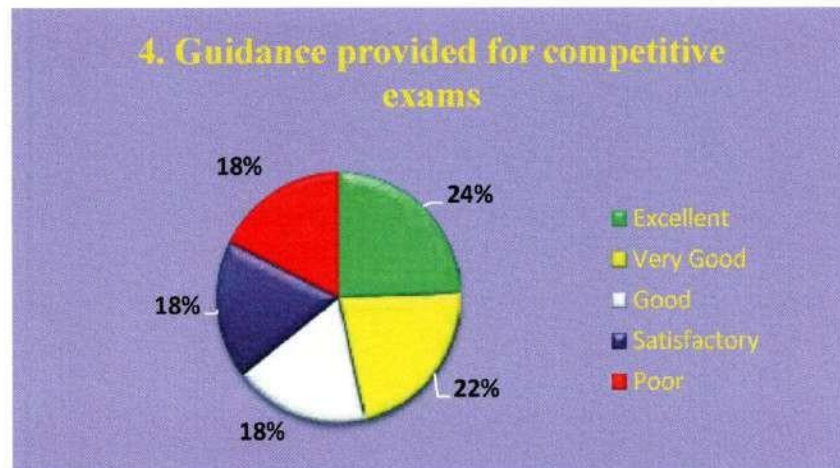

This breakdown suggests that a significant portion of students (47%) rated the opportunities to enhance entrepreneurship skills as Excellent, followed by a considerable number (27%) rating it as Very Good, 18% recorded as Good, 5% reported as Satisfactory and 3% recorded as Poor.



This breakdown suggests that regarding guidance provided for competitive exams, 24% of the students recorded Excellent, 22% reported as Very Good, 18% as Good, 18% recorded as Satisfactory and 18% felt as Poor.

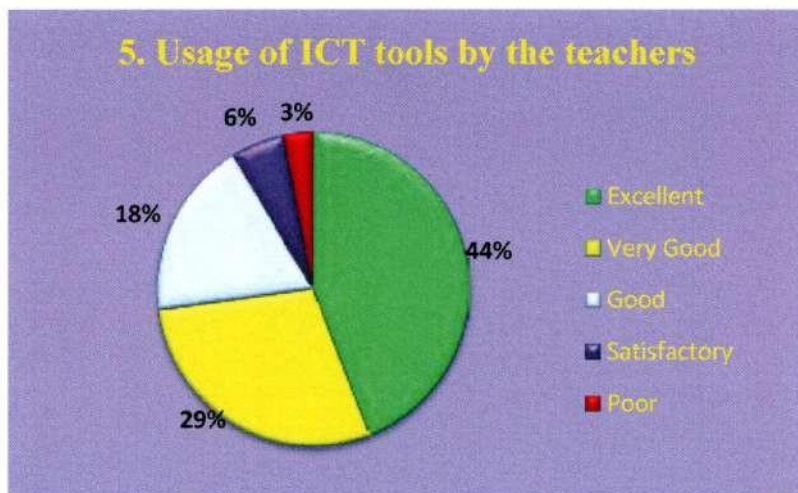

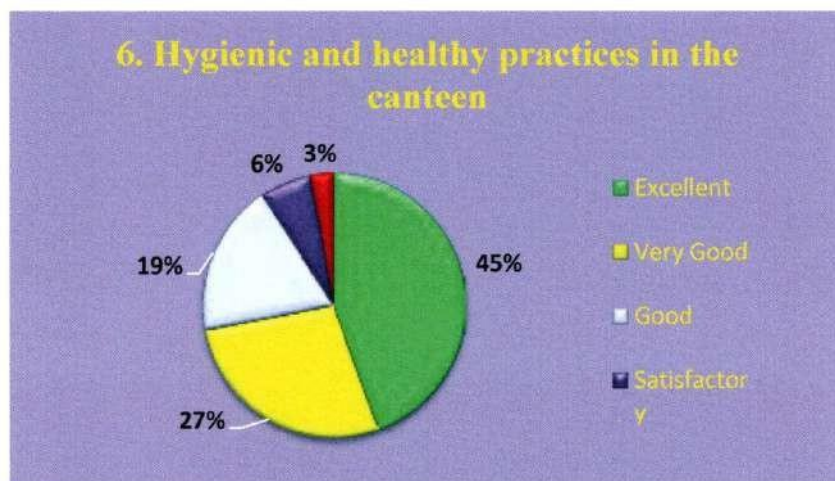

This feedback suggests that while the use of ICT tools by teachers is generally well-received and beneficial, 44% of the students recorded as Excellent, 29% as Very Good, 18% as Good, 6% students recorded as Satisfactory and 3 % as Poor.



45% rated the canteen's hygienic and health practices as Excellent and another 27% rated them as Very Good, 19% who rated them as Good and 6% as Satisfactory, 3% of students rated the usage as Poor.

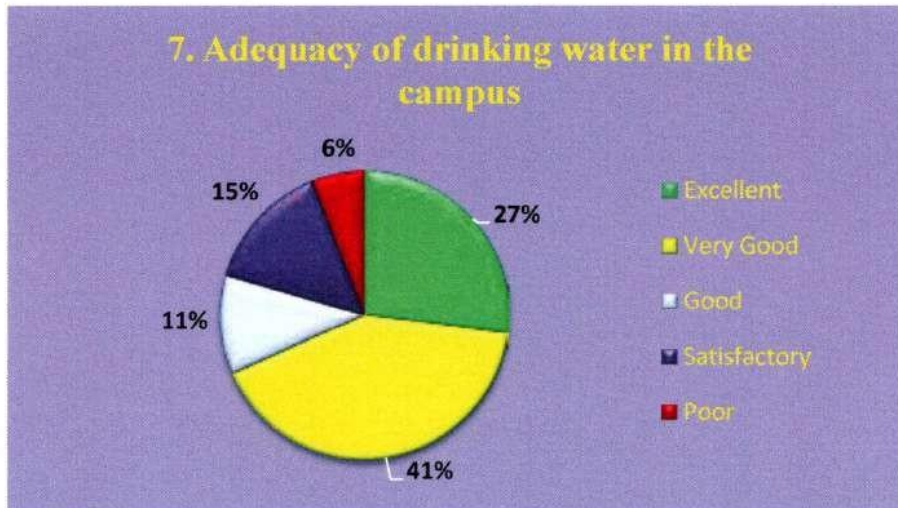




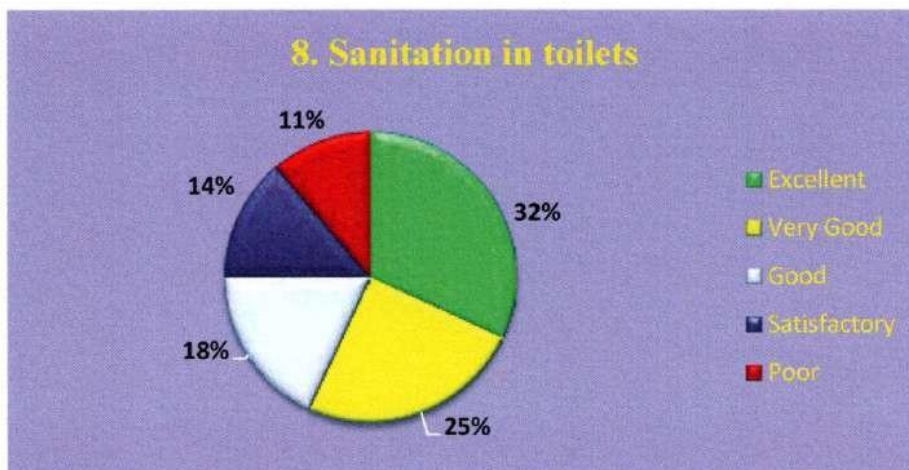

27 % of the students rated the adequacy of drinking water in the campus as Excellent, 41% reported as Very Good, 11% recorded as Good and 15% reported as Satisfactory and 6 % as Poor.



This feedback might be beneficial for the campus administration to assess the sanitation facilities in toilets. 32% of the students felt Excellent about the adequacy of drinking water in the campus, 25% as Very Good, 18% rated as Good, 14% reported as Satisfactory and 11% as Poor. This feedback is valuable as it highlights areas where further attention may be needed to ensure that the sanitation facilities meet everyone's expectations.

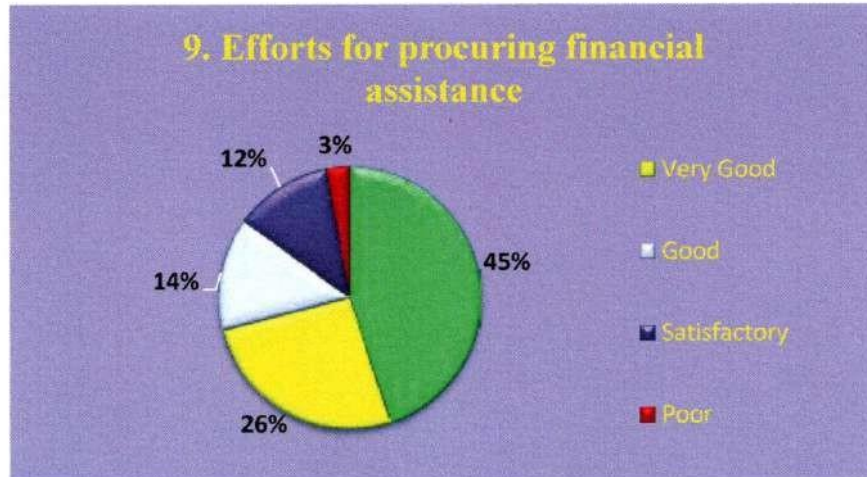

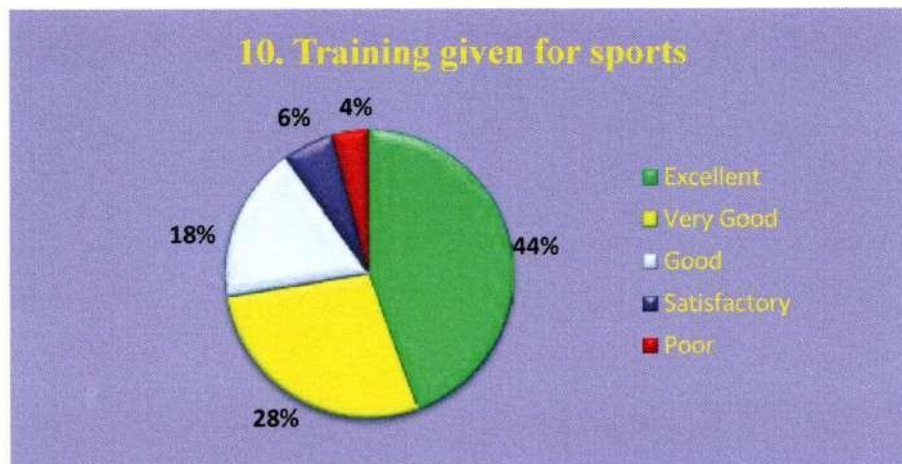

45% of the students rated the effect of procuring financial assistance in the campus is Excellent, 41% reported it as Very Good, 11% recorded as Good and 15% reported it as Satisfactory and 6 % as Poor.
