Report

A six day Professional Development Programme was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our College from 23rd September to 30th September 2022 for the teaching faculty in the Seminar Hall at 2.45 p.m. in order to:

- Impart professional ethics to be followed by faculty at work place.
- Create an awareness about the nuances of writing proposals for minor and major projects.
- Train the faculty on using Canva App in PPTs and videos.
- Enable the faculty to learn PO and CO mapping.
- Facilitate the faculty to set questions based on Bloom's Taxonomy &
- Educate the faculty to create e-content with ease using various apps.

Day 1: Professional Ethics for Teachers - 23.09.2022

An orientation on the topic "Professional Ethics for Teachers" was given by Dr. T. Lilly Golda, Coordinator, IQAC. Dr. T. Lilly Golda who spoke about the importance of being organized in filing documents. She also listed out the criterion-wise documents to be maintained by every department from 2019-2020 till date for the purpose of Internal and External Academic Audit.

Day 2: Using Canva effectively for PPTs and making Videos – 26.09.2022

On 26th September 2022, Dr. V. Shyamala Susan, Head and Assistant Professor, PG Department of Computer Science gave hands on training to the faculty on Using Canva App for creating PPTS and videos in the Computer Science Lab. She explained how to download Canva App for the purpose of designing certificates, invitations, bookmarks and adding videos and images in PPTs.

Day 3: Nuances of Project Proposal Writing – 27.09.2022

Dr. Selvam, Assistant Professor of Geology, V.O. Chidambaram College, Thoothukudi was the resource person for the third day of the programme titled "Nuances of Project Proposal Writing". The resource person gave detailed information regarding the topics and fields related to which project proposals can be applied. He insisted that the proposal should be novel and quality publications, especially in Scopus is mandatory for our proposals getting sanctioned. Dr. Selvam informed that justification must be given for every expenditure while applying for proposals, He gave adequate details about various funding agencies like TNSCST, DST, DBT, UGC, AICTE, DRDO, Indo-Us Science and Technology Forum, SERB, TARE, SERB-STAR and so on. He further emphasised that only government sanctioned programmes would be considered at the time of recruitment and advised the faculty to select innovative proposals by collaborating with faculty of other disciplines.

Day 4: PO - CO Mapping & Attainment - 28.09.2022

On 28th September 2022, Dr. A. Muthuraman, Assistant Professor of Zoology, Sadakathullah Appa College, Tirunelveli gave a presentation on the topic "PO & CO Mapping and Attainment" in which he elaborated on the concept, the need and usefulness of PO and CO mapping. He explained the three domains of Bloom's Taxonomy and six metrics of Cognitive level domain which is followed by educational institutions. The resource person also trained the faculty as to how to calculate attainment level with examples and gave an overview of the five steps to be followed in CO and PO mapping and attainment.

Day 5: E-Content Development – 29.09.2022

Dr. N. Rathna, Assistant Professor of Physics, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi trained the faculty on E-Content Development on 29th September 2022 in the Computer Science Lab. The trainer explained various tools for content creation like video recording and streaming, screen/video/audio recording tools, video editing tools, mind map and drawing tools. Participants were asked to download various apps like Screenrec, Screencast-omatic, ITOP, OBS, DRAW.10 and Mindmaster and the resource person trained the participants to create contents using these Apps.

Day 6: Framing Questions Based on Bloom's Taxonomy 30.09.2022

The last day of the Professional Development Programme was handled by Dr. Monica Ramraj, Head and Associate Professor, PG and Research Department of English in the Seminar Hall. The resource person gave an understandable presentation about Bloom's Taxonomy and the six categories of cognitive process, that is, remember, understand, apply, analyse, evaluate and create by quoting examples. She listed out the action verbs and insisted the faculty to use them while framing questions. 96 faculty attended the six-day faculty development programme which came to an end with Dr. T. Lilly Golda, Coordinator, Internal Quality Assurance Cell of our College proposing vote of thanks. The arrangements for the six-day PDP were made by the members of IQAC.



FDP Report - 27.03.2023

The IQAC of A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thooothukudi, Tamil Nadu organized a one month FDP on Computer Training Programme conducted for the newly recruited non-teaching staff members. The training programme commenced on 20th January 2023 and concluded on 27.03.2023.

Objectives: The primary objectives of the training programme were as follows:

- 1. To familiarize participants with basic computer skills.
- To develop proficiency in using commonly utilized software applications, such as word processing, spreadsheets, and presentations and Tamil typewriting.
- 3. To enhance skills in using email, internet browsing, and online communication tools.

Resource Persons: Mrs. M. Maharasi and Mrs. M. Selvalakshmi Venue: Computer Lab-3.

Training Methodology: The training programme employed a combination of theoretical sessions, hands-on practical exercises, and interactive group activities. Mrs. M. Maharasi and Mrs. M. Selvalakshmi, the resource persons, demonstrated expertise and proficiency in delivering the training content effectively. They provided clear explanations, answered participants' queries, and encouraged active participation throughout the sessions.

Training Highlights:

- Theoretical Sessions: Participants received in-depth theoretical knowledge regarding computer applications. Topics covered included computer fundamentals, operating systems, word processing, spreadsheets, presentations, Tamil typing and internet usage.
- Practical Exercises: Participants actively engaged in hands-on practical exercises to reinforce their understanding of the concepts taught. They had the opportunity to apply their newly acquired skills using computers and software applications.

Assessments: Regular assessments were conducted to gauge participants' progress and understanding. These assessments allowed trainers to identify areas of improvement and provide targeted support and guidance.

Outcomes and Impact: The one-month computer training programme yielded several positive outcomes and had a significant impact on the participants, including:

- Improved Computer Literacy: Participants demonstrated enhanced computer literacy and gained confidence in using various software applications, such as word processors, spreadsheets, and presentation tools and Tamil typing.
