


Analysis of Feedback from Students

A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses




44% of students have rated the content of the syllabus as Excellent and 25% Very Good, indicating a high level of satisfaction with the quality of the syllabus content. There are still 19% students who have rated the content as Good and 9% as Satisfactory, 3% students who have rated the content as Poor.




Generally positive feedback has been received from students regarding coverage of syllabi, with 42% rating them as Excellent and 23% rating them as Very Good. This indicates that a majority of students found the courses to be valuable and beneficial. 21% recorded Good and 10% felt Satisfactory and 4% rated as Poor.

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














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









