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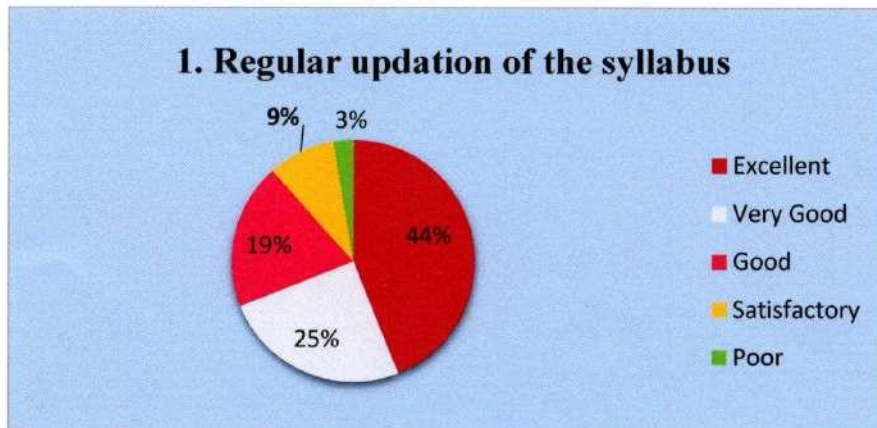

### Analysis of Feedback from Students

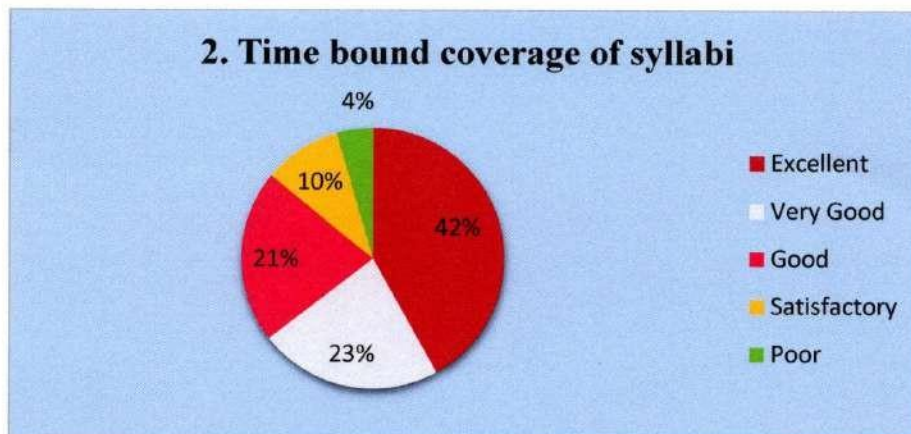

#### A Graphical Representation of the Collected Feedback Responses



44% of students have rated the content of the syllabus as Excellent and 25% Very Good, indicating a high level of satisfaction with the quality of the syllabus content. There are still 19% students who have rated the content as Good and 9% as Satisfactory, 3% students who have rated the content as Poor.



. Generally positive feedback has been received from students regarding coverage of syllabi, with 42% rating them as Excellent and 23% rating them as Very Good. This indicates that a majority of students found the courses to be valuable and beneficial. 21% recorded Good and 10% felt Satisfactory and 4% rated as Poor.

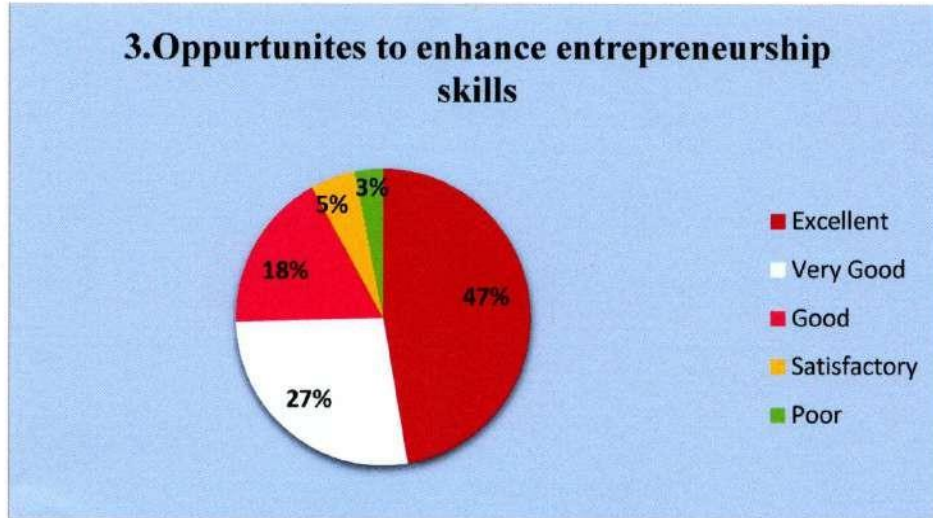
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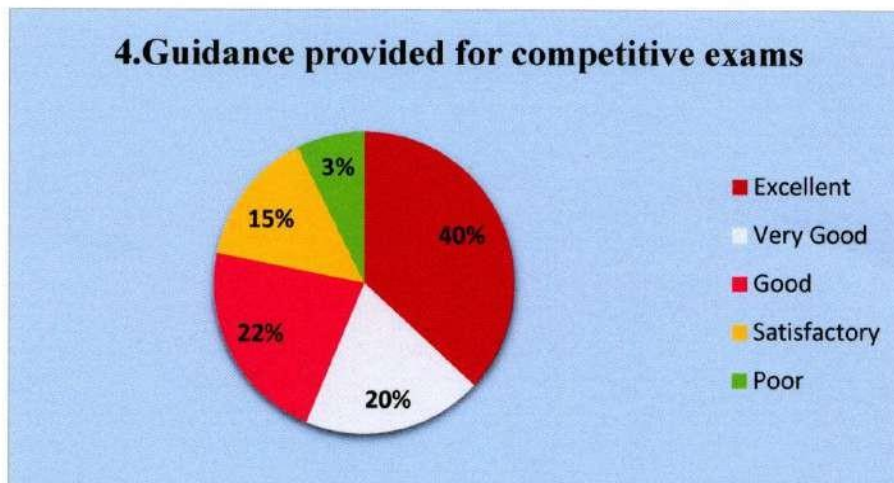
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This breakdown suggests that a significant portion of students (47%) rated the opportunities to enhance entrepreneurship skills as Excellent, followed by a considerable number (27%) rating it as Very Good, 18% as Good, 5% reported as Satisfactory and 3% recorded as Poor.



This breakdown suggests that regarding guidance provided for competitive exams for students 40% of the students recorded as Excellent about the skill level of teachers, 19% reported as Very Good, 22% as Good, 15% recorded as Satisfactory and 3% felt as Poor.

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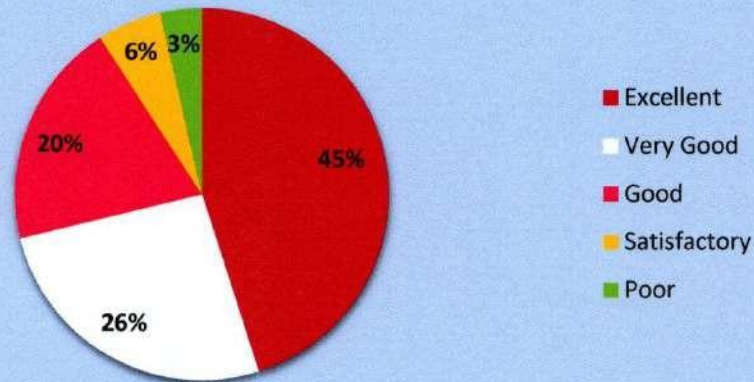


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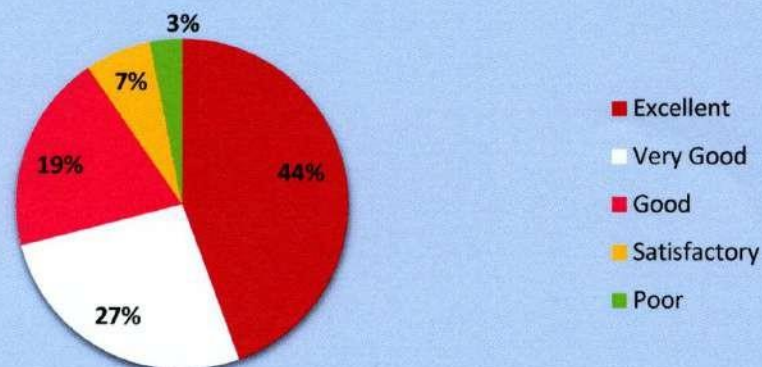

#### 5. Usage of ICT tools by the teachers



This feedback suggests that the use of ICT tools by teachers is generally well-received and beneficial. 45% of the students recorded as Excellent, 26% as Very Good, 20% as Good, 6% students recorded as Satisfactory and 3 % as Poor.

#### 6. Hygienic and healthy practices in the canteen



44% rated them as Excellent and another 27% rated them as Very Good, there is a 19% who rated them as Good and 7% as Satisfactory. 3% of students rated the usage as Poor.

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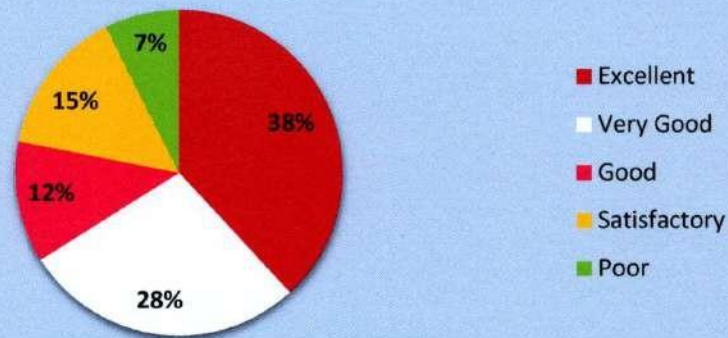


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#### 7. Adequacy of drinking water in the campus

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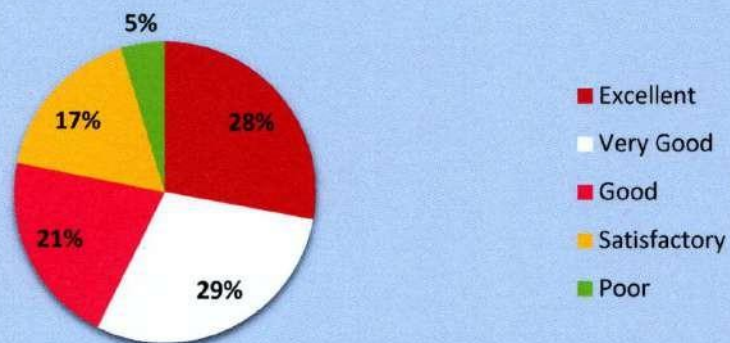


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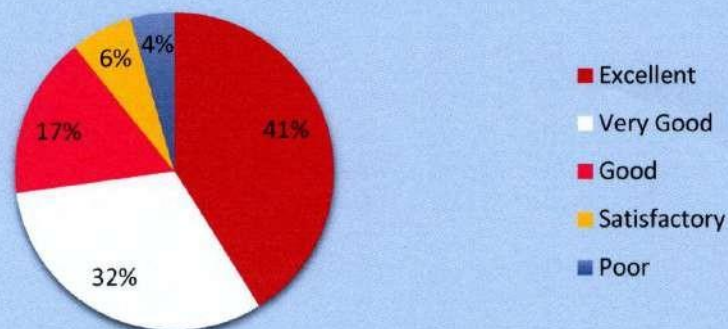
