A one-day Virtual International Conference on Education and Research: Reforms in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century was organised by Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College in association with Universitas Al Asyariah Mandar, Indonesia, Yes You Can International, United Kingdom and Cape Forum – You Trust, Nagercoil, Tamil Nadu on 26<sup>th</sup> April 2022 in Zoom in order to:

- Create an awareness about the reforms, in the field of education in 21<sup>st</sup> century, New Education Policy and various Acts implemented in India for inclusive education
- Impart knowledge about the teaching and learning methods followed internationally
- Emphasise the importance of research and innovation for the growth of a country

The Conference began at 10.00 a.m with the prayer song followed by the welcome address of the Principal Dr.N.Meenakumari. Dr.T.Lilly Golda, Coordinator of Internal Quality Assurance Cell introduced the theme of the conference. Proceedings of the conference were released by our Principal Dr.N.Meenakumari. The resource person for the first technical session was Dr.Muthmainnah, Lecturer at Al Asyariah Mandar University, Indonesia. Dr.D.Radha, Assistant Professor of P.G and Research Centre of Mathematics and member of IQAC introduced the resource person. The guest speaker gave an informative presentation on the topic “Education in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century” in which she explained about the 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as literary skills, listening skills, life skills, and critical thinking skills which are demanded by the employers. She shared the teaching and learning methods followed in Indonesia, that is, about Assure Model, digital pedagogy, funtainment and so on which make students more engaged in classroom.

The guest speaker for the second technical session was Dr.Queen Elizabeth, CEO of Yes You Can International, United Kingdom. Dr.Bala Deepa Arasi Assistant Professor of P.G and Research Centre of Mathematics and member of IQAC introduced the resource person. Dr.Queen Elizabeth gave a precise speech on the topic “Reforms in Management and Education”. The speaker gave a presentation on the strategies to be followed in human resource

## Adjunct Foreign Faculty

**Contractual/ Part Time/Adjunct Foreign Faculty  
Agreement Form**

The agreement is bilaterally made on August, 2020

**Between**

The DMI-St.John the Baptist University, Mangochi, Malawi represented through Registrar, DMISJBU, Malawi hereinafter called the "First Party" on one part and **Dr.V.SHYAMALA SUSAN** S/D of Mr/Ms. **Mr.VINCENT**..... hereinafter called the "Second Party" on the other part.

Whereas the DMI-St.John the Baptist University, Mangochi, Malawi (DMISJBU) desires to engage service of Second Party (**Dr.V.SHYAMALA SUSAN**) as per the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth.

**And**

Therefore, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

**1.0 Terms of Reference:**

- a. The Second Party will be appointed as a Part-Time faculty. The objectives, roles and responsibilities for the positions are detailed in **Annexure 1**. The terms of reference shall be modified from time to time related to the requirements of the DMISJBU. Working hours and holidays shall be those applying to the Republic of Malawi to which the Second Party is assigned.
- b. The Second Party is obligated to work as Part-Time faculty under the direction and administrative control of the Registrar, DMISJBU.
- c. The appointed faculty has agreed to perform the required duties as per the present job description prescribed for this post by DMISJBU and further it is governed by the rules of the DMISJBU from time to time.
- d. The Second Party agrees that he will at all time faithfully, industriously do the best of his/her skill, ability, knowledge and exposure, and perform all of the duties are required of the position.
- e. It is also understood and agreed by the Second Party that his assignments, duties and responsibilities and reporting arrangements shall be changed by the DMISJBU in its sole discretion without causing termination of this agreement.

**2.0 Duration of Agreement**

- a. The contract is valid to teach mutually agreed lesson/module **055 CS 52 – Computer Organization & Architecture - V Semester** for **B.E (Programme)** from **30.08.2021 to 27.01.2022**
- b. The contract shall be for a period of **150** calendar days from **30.08.2021** and may ordinarily, subject to satisfactory performance of duties and midterm evaluation of the work concomitant to the provisions of this agreement be renewed. The Second Party shall either have any rights or lien on the contractual job and the services shall stand automatically terminated at the expiry of the contract period.

- c. There will be performance appraisal after the completion of each module in respective semester and if two consecutive appraisals are average the contract will stand automatically cancelled.-
- d. The contract is subject to be renewed purely at the discretion of the DMISJBU. Non-renewal of the contract by the DMISJBU might imply that there is no need for part-time appointees.

### 3.0 Remuneration

- a. The honorarium for Second Party will be as per the scheme provide in the **Annexure 2**.
- b. As full consideration for the work performed by the Second Party under the terms of Agreement, the First Party shall pay the Second Party a remuneration of USD /- ( ) and in addition, such other financial benefits as may be admissible to him/her.
- c. All payments will be paid by Banks transfer as per the details submitted in **Annexure 3**.

### 4.0 Status of the Second Party (Signatory)

The Second Party shall have the status of Contractual/Part Time/ Adjunct employee and shall not be considered in any respect as a regular faculty of the DMISJBU.

### 5.0 Rights and Obligations of the Second Party (Signatory)

- a. The rights and obligations of the Second Party are strictly limited to the terms and conditions of the Agreement. Accordingly, the Second Party shall not be entitled to any benefit, payment, subsidy, compensation or pension from DMISJBU.
- b. The Second Party is not exempted from taxation as per tax laws of Republic of Malawi.

### 6.0 Rescission

- a. Either of the party may rescind the Agreement at any point of time by giving the other party, at least one month notice in written stating the intention of withdrawal, and is mandatory for both parties of this Agreement. However, the period of notice can be reduced to 15 (fifteen) days or honorarium in lieu thereof by the first party in the following circumstances.
  - i. If the post of the second party ceases to exist or is not approved by relevant Government authority/DMISJBU or abolished at any point of time for some reasons or others.
  - ii. If the funding under any head for the post hold by any Contractual/Part Time/ Adjunct employee ceases at any point of time.
- b. When ever the Second Party does not attend the duties from the date of submission of his/her resignation to the Concern Authority, without waiting for completion of one month mandatory notice period from the date of such submission of resignation or acceptance of his resignation, whichever is earlier, the Second Party shall forfeit his/her claims on the pending financial dues if any from the DMISJBU and the First Party shall have the liberty, not to issue any NOC or Experience Certificate for such omission on the part of Second Party.

### 7.0 Termination

- a. In case of improper conduct by the Second Party, the DMISJBU may terminate this Agreement and no compensation shall be payable in such a case.
- b. This contract is issued on the understanding all the information given by the Second Party on his/her application form and during the direct/online interview are correct, true and complete. If it is found at any point of time that the information given when seeking

appointment is not complete and false and/or any significant information has been knowingly suppressed, the DMISJBU will have rights either to withdraw this letter of contractual/Part Time/ Adjunct engagement before he/she joins or terminate the appointment at any point of time after he/she has taken up service with the DMISJBU without any notice or compensation.

- c. Notwithstanding anything contained here-in-above, the services of the Second Party may be terminated at any point of time by the competent authority of the DMISJBU if the Second Party is found he/she involved in criminal offence or guilty of any insubordination, intemperance or other misconduct or of breach or non-performance or at the completion of the contract period as mentioned.

#### 8.0 Job Abandonment

The Second Party is deemed to abandon his/her job when for a period of 4 consecutive days has been absent without the permission from the higher authority.

#### 9.0 Copyright & Intellectual Property Rights

The DMISJBU shall have rights for all the findings, designs, patents and other intellectual property rights of the projects done under the supervision of the Second Party and also all modes of prepared learning materials by same during this contract.


#### 10.0 Confidentiality

The Second Party shall exercise utmost discretion with regard to all official matters. He/She shall not communicate to any person any information known to him by reason of his official position, which has not been made public, except in the course of his duties or by authorization of the DMISJBU. These obligations do not cease with expiry of this Agreement.

This Agreement may be amended as and when it is required by the DMISJBU.


