

Abstract. Let $D = (V, A)$ be a digraph with $|V| = n$. A function $f: V(D) \rightarrow [Y_n]$ is said to be a Gaussian twin neighborhood-prime labeling of D , if it is both Gaussian in and out degree neighborhood-prime labeling. A digraph which admits a Gaussian twin neighborhood-prime labeling then it is called a Gaussian twin neighborhood-prime digraph. In this paper, we establish the Gaussian twin neighborhood prime labeling in wheel digraphs 2010 Mathematics Subject classification: 05C78.

Keywords: Gaussian, integers, prime, neighborhood, digraph, wheel.

1. Introduction

The field of graph theory plays a vital role in various fields. A directed graph D consists of a finite set V of vertices and a collection of ordered pairs of distinct vertices. Graph labeling is an assignment of integers to the vertices or edges or both subject to certain conditions. The concept of graph labeling was introduced by Rosa in [1]. T. J. Rajesh Kumar and T.K.MathewVarkey [12] introduced the concept of Gaussian neighborhood prime labeling of a graph. K.Palani [9] et.al.introduced the concept of Gaussian twin neighborhood prime labeling in digraphs. In this paper, we investigate the existence of Gaussian twin neighborhood prime labeling in wheel digraphs.

The following definitions are from [6] and [13].

Definition 1.1. Gaussian integers are complex numbers of the form $\gamma = x + iy$ where x and y are integers and $i^2 = -1$. The set of Gaussian integers is usually denoted by $\mathbb{Z}[i]$.

A Gaussian integer is called even if $1 + i$ divides γ . Otherwise it is an odd Gaussian integer.

Definition 1.2. A Gaussian integer $\alpha = a + ib \in \mathbb{Z}[i]$ is prime if and only if either

(i) $\alpha = \pm(1 \pm i)$

(ii) $N(\alpha) = a^2 + b^2$ is a prime integer congruent to 1 (mod 4), or





- Conduct research oriented & other programmes by both the colleges jointly

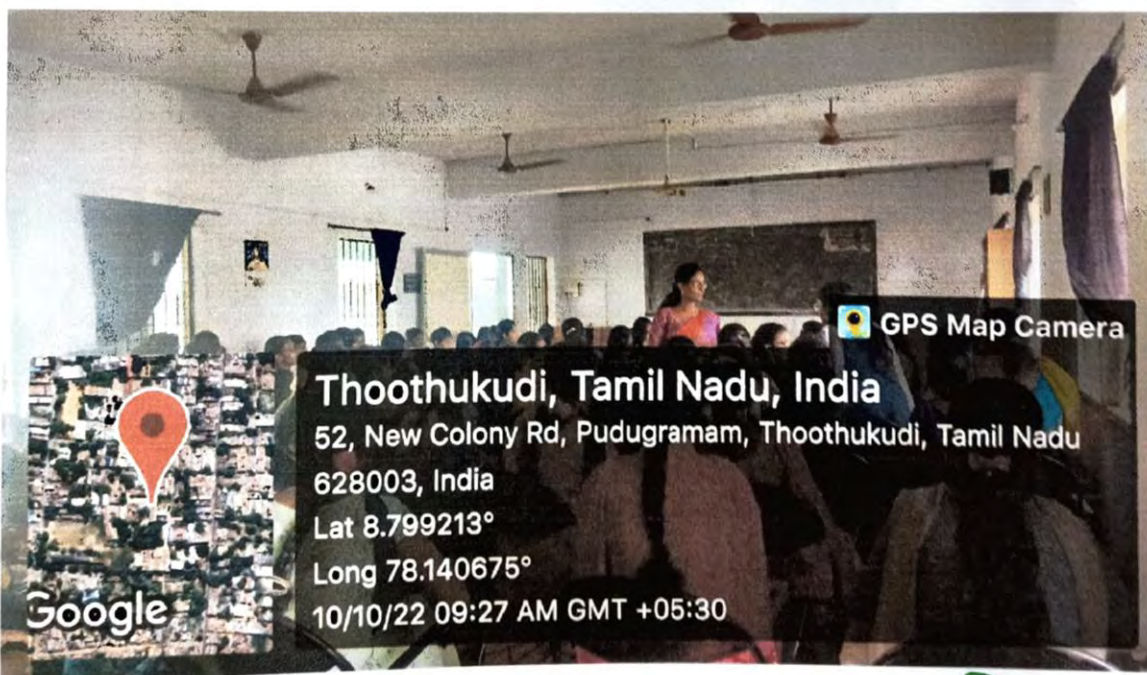

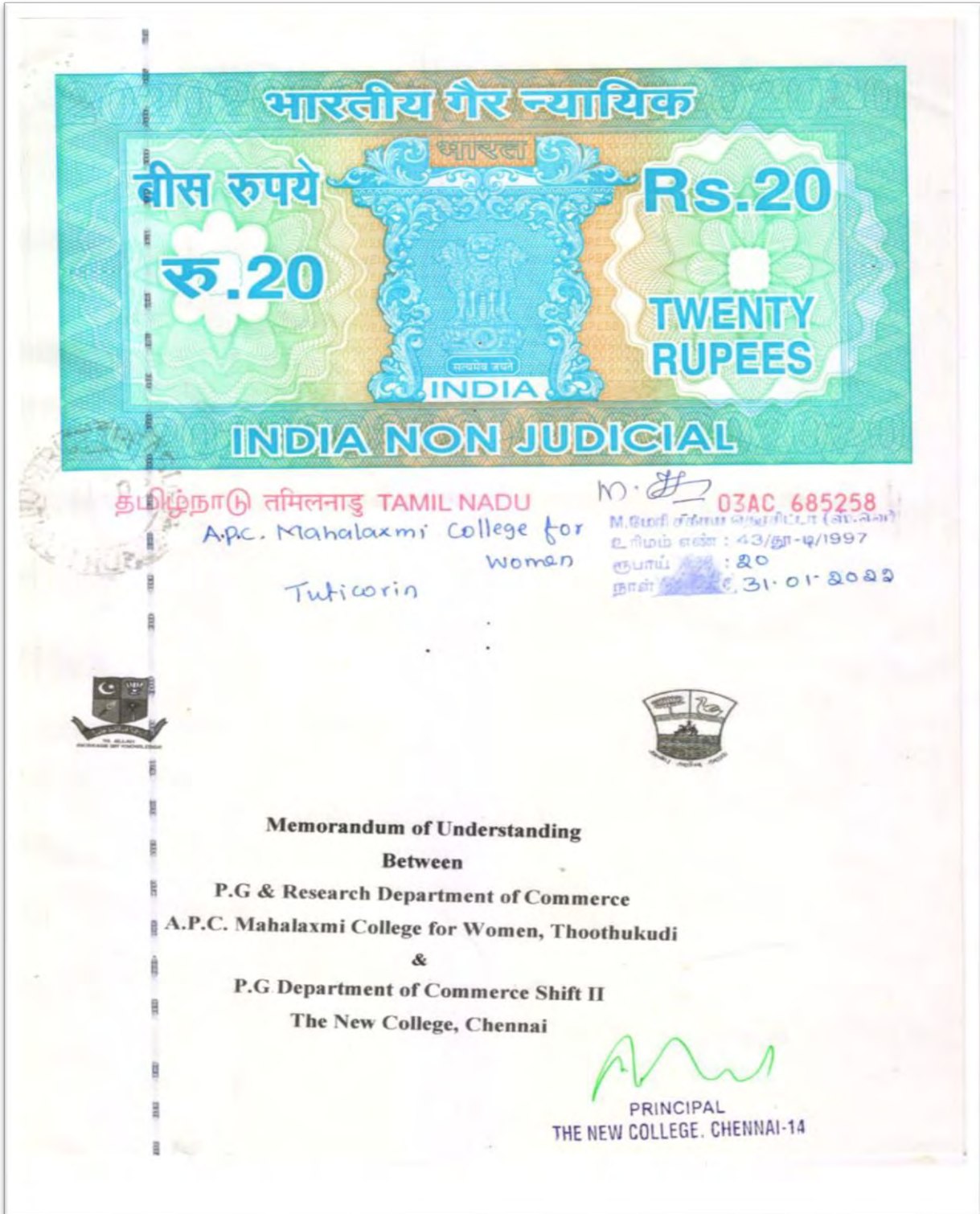



Approximately 96 Students participated in the home Institution and 50 Students participated in the New College Chennai. Students acquired a novel teaching and learning experience from both faculties.

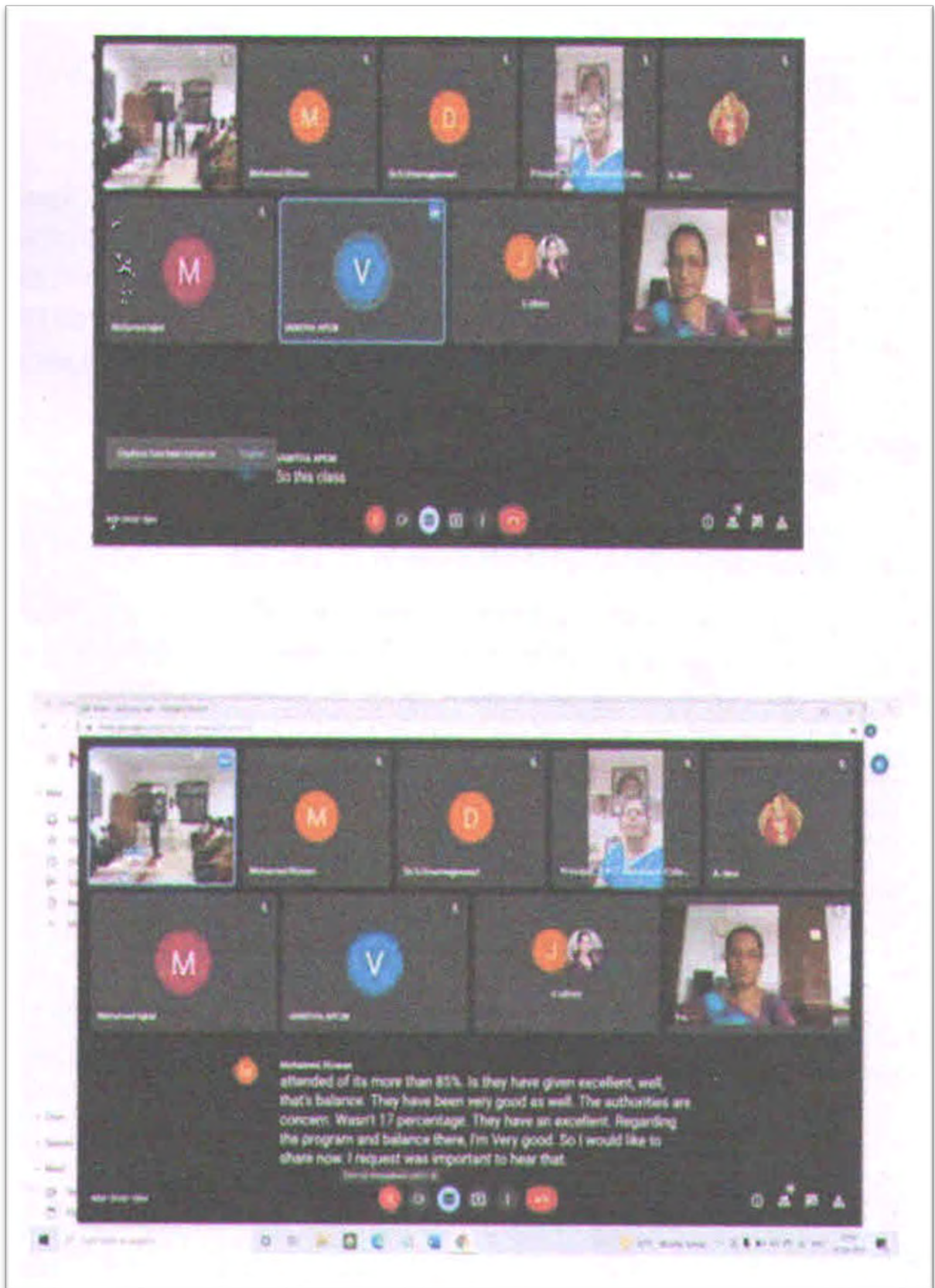

5. The student's database as required by Redington Foundation will be shared by the College SPOC with the Foundation, which will enable the Foundation to select the list of meritorious and deserving students for attending any of the training programs conducted by the Foundation. - it shall inform every student and obtain all necessary consents from the students while sharing the database with the Foundation.
6. Any training program provided by Redington Foundation will be done as part of their CSR activity. If the training involves any reputed brand certifications, Redington Foundation will bear such course fee, however the student/college shall have to bear the examination fees and any certification fees additionally required, since the certification will be provided to only those candidates who have taken up the certification examinations and are declared successful.
 7. The students for Redington Foundation's online training will be selected after carefully examining the eligibility criteria as laid down by Redington Foundation and also after qualifying through an aptitude test.
 8. As per the eligibility criteria, students in second year and final year UG programs are eligible to apply for the trainings, provided they fulfill the following criteria:
 - a) Students should have no arrears in their previous semesters
 - b) Students should have an average of 60% or equivalent CGPA from all previous semesters.







This addendum will become an integral part of the original MOU, from the date of execution of this Addendum by the Foundation. The MOU is incorporated by reference into this Addendum and except as specifically mentioned herein, all terms and conditions of the MOU will remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
