

3. OBLIGATIONS OF THE SECOND PARTY





Coaching for TNPSC and Banking Examinations commenced from 1st September 2022 in the Auditorium for the students who have expressed their consent to attend the classes. Initially, MoU was signed with Suresh Academy on 27th August 2022 and the classes were inaugurated by Mr. D. Sugesh Samuel, Founder of Suresh Academy. 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

Background:

The parties entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and wish to continue their cooperation in order to provide opportunities for students to pursue their studies.

The MoU was signed with following objectives:

1. Faculty Exchange:

The parties will arrange to send some faculty members in each other's organizations for:

- Teaching a course work for the entire semester/ course work.
- Short term specialized lectures and courses (10 days to 3 months duration)
- · Joint research work and any other similar academic activities
- Parties may be considered for food and accommodation with nominal cost on prior request at the time of visit.

2. Students study tours:

Parties agrees to arrange study tour of their respective students in each other's
institute. The travel expenses and boarding, lodging etc., shall be borne by the
guest institution where as the host institution will provide study tour and learning
opportunities in its organization.

3. Joint hosting of international conferences:

Parties agrees to explore the opportunity of organizing State/National/
 International conferences as co-host. The terms and conditions shall be worked out on a case-to-case basis.

4. Research collaboration for funding proposals and research publications:

- Parties agrees for applying the collaborative research proposals to get grants and work collaboratively to succeed the research.
- Jointly publish research articles on collaborative research.

5. Sharing research persons for seminar and conferences:

 Parties agrees to accept and extending their faculty members as a resource person to conduct seminars and conferences on request.



6. Online or virtual skill development programs for faculty & Students

 Parties may conduct online or virtual skill development programs for faculty members & students.

All parties shall:

Keep all information or materials acquired or produced in connection with this agreement confidential and shall not use or disclose or otherwise make available to any person such information or materials in any form without prior written consent:

The following procedures is used to resolving any disputes arising from or in relation to the agreement:

- Use their best endeavors to resolve the dispute through negotiation on the principle of good faith (ensuring the dispute is handled by appropriate level of their respective management) and
- If the parties failed to reach a resolution to the dispute within 30 days (or such
 longer period as the parties may agree upon in writing), the dispute shall be
 referred to and settled by a mutually agreed arbitrator and such arbitral award can
 be final, conclusive and binding on the parties.

This Agreement

- a. Shall be effective as of the date of its execution by the parties.
- b. Shall be valid for a period of 3 years, unless terminated earlier pursuant to this agreement.
- c. May be amended in writing signed by the parties.
- d. May be terminated at any time by one party giving to the other parties' written notice of termination not less than 60 days in advance.
- e. May be terminated immediately by one party sending written notice to the other parties if the other parties are in breach of any term of this agreement and fail to remedy the breach within seven (7) days after being requested in writing or the other party goes into liquidation or makes a composition or arrangement with its creditors generally, or take advantage of any statue for the relief of insolvent debtors; and
- f. May be renewed on terms agreed by the parties on or before its expiration.





PURPOSE OF THE MoU
