- ✚ To promote transformative education for ethical leadership

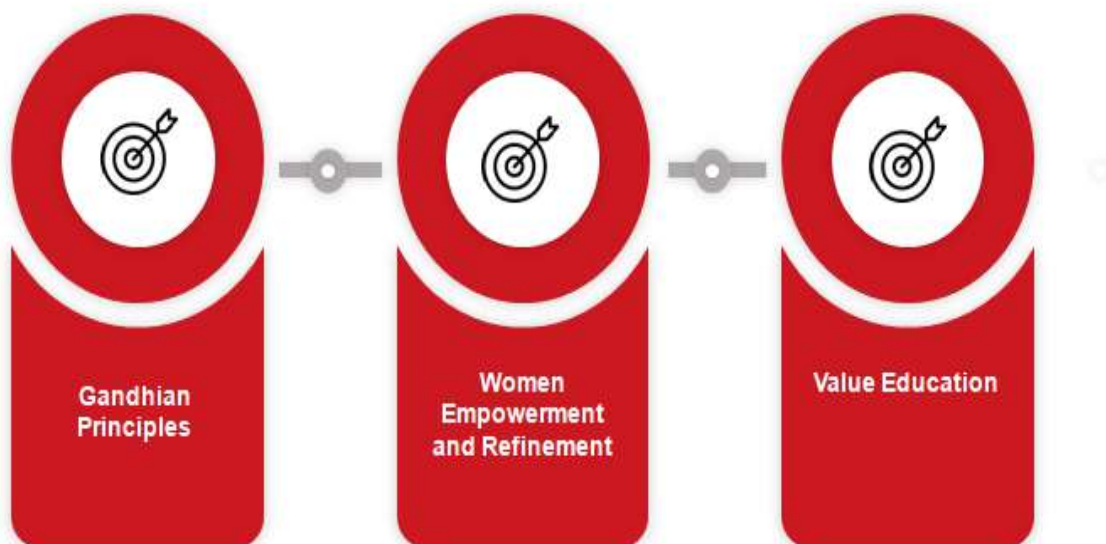
