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
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Weed Cleaning Programme


Palm Plantation Programme






Plant distribution after propagation


Webinar: Surface Ozone Air Pollution and Its Impacts on the Environment

Department of Physics organized an online webinar on the topic "Surface Ozone Air Pollution and its impacts on the Environment" on 15.07.2020 at 11.00 A.M. for the academic year 2019-2020. The Platform of the meeting was Zoom. Dr. T. Chithambarathanu, Principal, S. T. Hindu College, Nagercoil & Member Syndicate - Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli acted as the resource person. The objective of this programme was to educate the students about the sources of air pollution, its effect on human health, ecosystems and the environment as well as strategies to mitigate and reduce its harmful effect through policy, technology and behavioural change. The Chief Guest delivered his presidential address. In his talk, Causes and Formation Mechanisms, Health Effects, Environmental Impacts Monitoring and Measurement Techniques and Technological solutions of the ozone air pollution are discussed. Nearly 747 participants were benefitted by this programme. The participants got deeper understanding of the causes effects and complexities of surface ozone pollution and also they identified the areas for further research and exploration to better combat surface ozone pollution.




Poster Presentation Competition on OZONE - EARTH'S UMBRELLA




Green Belt Development Programme
