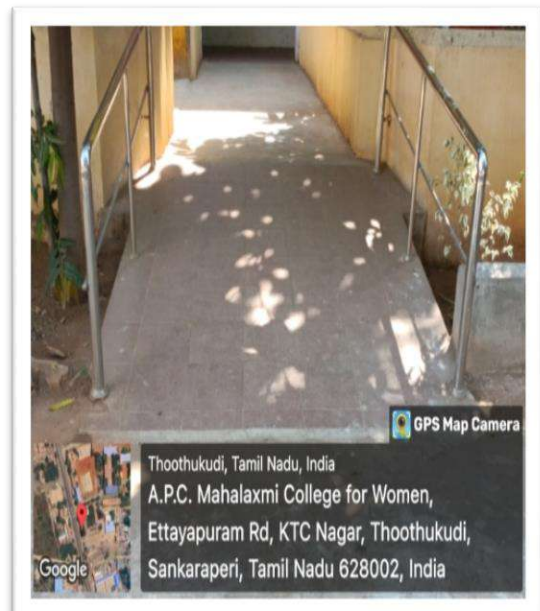

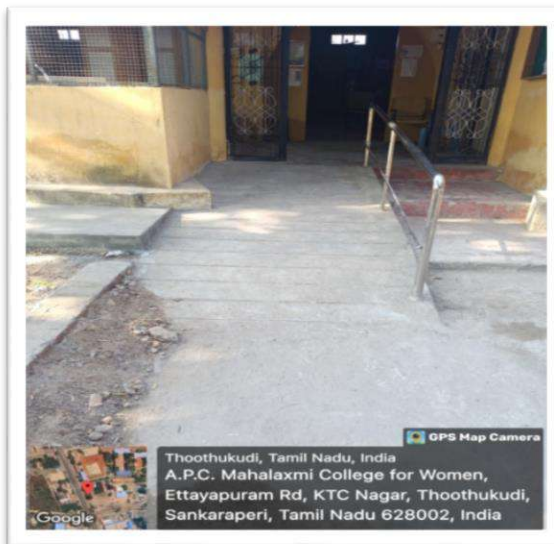

Ramp Facilities

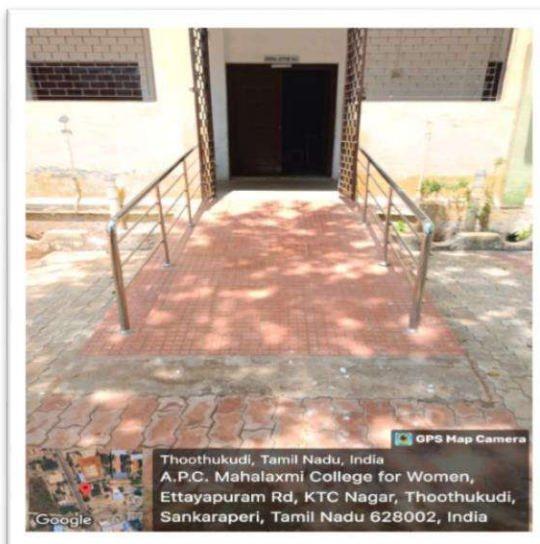

Wheelchairs

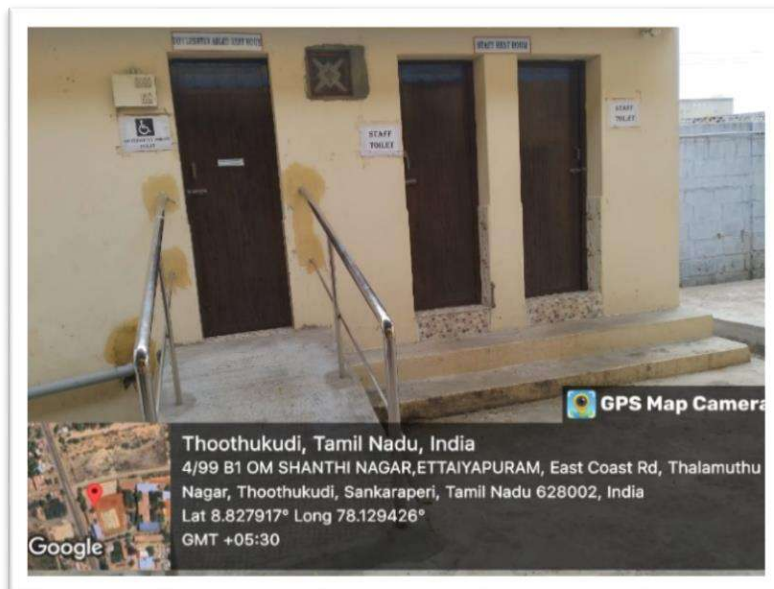
The college provides wheelchairs to facilitate the mobility of disabled students.

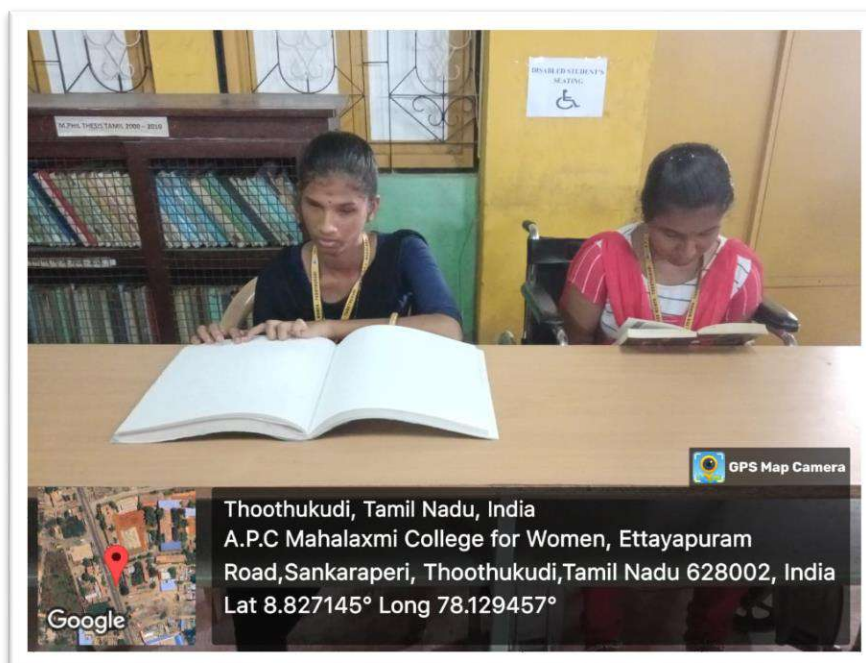
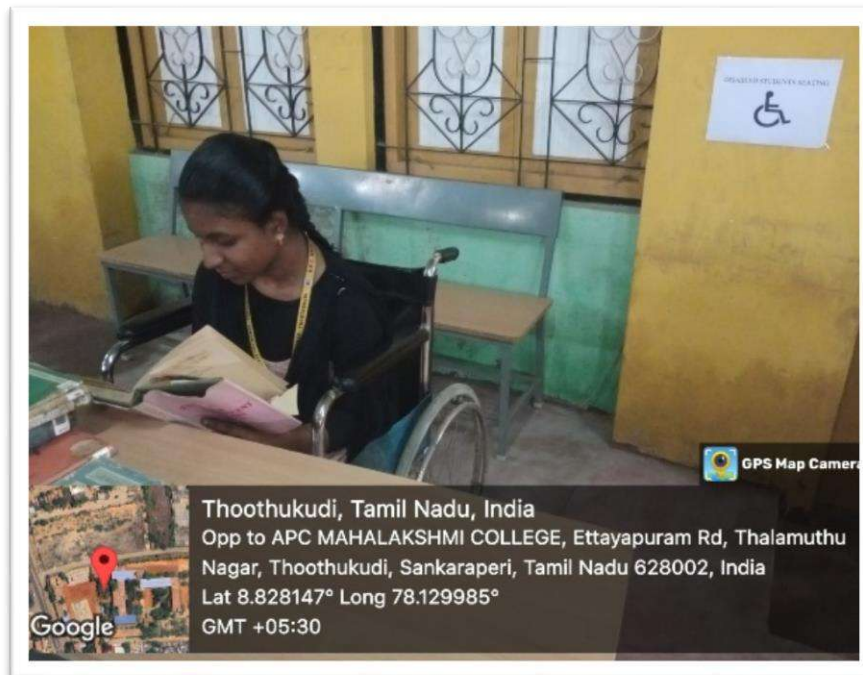
