
Need-based Survey from Teachers







A Series of Workshops to promote the use of technology among school teachers in the name of CONNECT was organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College on 18th, 19th, and 20th June 2020 through Zoom and APCM You Tube Channel at 5.30 p.m. These training programmes were conducted to:

- Facilitate School Teachers, especially Government School teachers to learn Google
 Apps that help to teach online during this COVID19 pandemic period.
- Provide training on installing Microsoft Teams and how to use various Apps in Microsoft Teams.

On 18th June, 2020, Miss. Ms.K.S. Anushya, Assistant Professor of English, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi imparted training on "Google Forms and its Applications" by accessing, creating and sharing Google Forms, viewing responses, creating spreadsheets and so on.

The second day of the technical session was handled by Dr.R.Samundeswari, Assistant Professor of Commerce, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi on 19th June, 2020. The trainer provided training on how to create Google Classrooms to teach students, post assignments and study materials, links, blogs, conduct quiz and online group discussions.

On 20th June, 2020, training on Microsoft Teams and its Applications was given by Mr.Senthil, IT Manager, Rathinam College of Arts and Science, Coimbatore. The resource Person trained the participants on installation of Microsoft Teams, creation of teams, channels, posting assignments, creation of quiz, uploading files, online teaching / meetings,

online video calling, recording, screen sharing, storage of files, clarification of doubts through chat box, downloading the attendance and so on.

There was an astounding response and active participation in these Three Days Workshop Series – CONNECT. 183 school teachers participated in the workshop series and made the sessions interactive. 

Tamilnadu State Council for Science and Technology aims to improve the Science Education in schools through conduct of Inservice Training to the Science Teachers. In this regard, PG & Research Department of Chemistry, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women organized a need-based In-Service Training Programme for Science Teachers belonging to Thoothukudi district in two phases, Phase I (25.07.2022 & 26.07.2022) and Phase II (23.08.2022 & 24.08.2022). The participants list comprising of 50 teachers was sent by the CEO, Thoothukudi who collected the training needs from the teachers in advance. 9 teachers from Thoothukudi taluk, 25 teachers from Kovilpatti taluk and 16 teachers from Thiruchendur taluk, totally 41 female teachers and 9 male teachers were participated. Accordingly, the schedule of the training programme was prepared.

The programme began on July 25, 2022 with the grand inaugural ceremony. Dr.H.Kohila Subathra Christy, Coordinator, Head & Assistant Professor of Chemistry welcomed the gathering. Dr. P. Bala Shanmuga Devi, Principal, A. P. C. Mahalaxmi College for Women presided over the programme. Mrs.T.Tamil Selvi, District Educational Officer, Thoothukudi District and Mrs.Pearcial Gnanamani, Assistant Project Officer, Thoothukudi inaugurated the programme and offered

felicitations. Dr.D.Shanmuga Priya, Assistant Professor of Chemistry proposed the formal vote of thanks. Saplings were planted by Dr. P. Bala Shanmuga Devi, Principal and Mrs.T.Tamil Selvi, District Educational Officer, Thoothukudi District. After the Besides the curricular areas in Science, the topics dealt by the resource persons during the phase I programme on 25.07.2022 included the sessions on Hard Water by Dr.D.Shanmuga Priya, Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Introduction to Algebra by Dr.R.Rajeswari, Assistant Professor of Maths, Optics by Mrs.R.Suya Padra Haridha, Assistant Professor of Physics, Protection of wild animals by Dr.T.Sakthika, Assistant Professor of Zoology, a laboratory session on Basic skills in computer by Mrs.P.Roselin, Assistant Professor of Computer Science and Mrs.A.Sahaya Arthy, Assistant Professor of Computer Science.

On 26.07.2022, the sessions dealt were Magnetism by Dr.N.Rathna, Assistant Professor of Physics, Basic skills in computer by Mrs.P.Roselin, Assistant Professor of Computer Science, Algebra by Dr.K.Rajendra Suba, Assistant Professor of Maths, Properties and reactions of Water by Dr.S.Sankara Vadivu a practical session A research on microorganisms by Dr.T.Sakthika, Assistant Professor of Zoology, and Dr.V.Jeyanthikumari, Assistant Professor of Zoology.

During the Phase II programme, the topics dealt by the resource persons on 23.08.2022, Files and folders in computer by Mrs.P.Roselin, Assistant Professor of Computer Science, acids and bases by Dr.C.Stella Packiam, Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Unicellular and multicellular organisms by Dr.V.Jeyanthikumari, Assistant Professor of Zoology, Introduction to algebra by Dr.R.Rajeswari, Assistant Professor of Maths a laboratory session on Physics practicals by Mrs.R.Suya Padra Haridha, Assistant Professor of Physics, and Ms.T.Mariselvi, Assistant Professor of Physics.

On 24.08.2022 the topics delivered by the resource persons were Heat by Dr.N.Rathna, Assistant Professor of Physics, Beauty in Maths by Dr.K.Rajendra

Suba, Assistant Professor of Maths, Protection of wild animals by Dr.T.Shakthika, Assistant Professor of Zoology, Basic skills in computer by Mrs.A.Sahaya Arthy, Assistant Professor of Computer Science and a laboratory practical session by Dr.D.Shanmuga Priya, Assistant Professor of Chemistry, Dr.S.Sankara Vadivu, Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Dr.C.Stella Packiam, Assistant Professor of Chemistry. This training programme concluded on August 24, 2022. Fifty science teachers belonging to Government Schools of Thoothukudi district participated in this In-Service Training programme.

On July 25, 2022 the Inaugural Session began with introduction of the aims and objectives of the programme by Dr. H.Kohila Subathra Christy, Programme Coordinator, followed by the welcome speech by Dr. P. Bala Shanmuga Devi, Principal, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women. Mrs. Tamizh Selvi, District Education Officer delivered a keynote speech on importance of understanding science. The training program empowered the teachers with exposure to multidimensional approach towards teaching-learning process. The need on mastery of skills in curriculum, technology, prior knowledge of students and their possible misconceptions or alternative conceptions were strongly emphasized throughout the programme. Considering the gravity of professional development of Teachers, every care for systematic inclusion of the key parameters for an objective oriented program were taken. The interactive sessions with many articulate resource persons with in depth intellect and yet with all the humility were true reflections of what really does teaching of a good science education mean. The visit by the Principal, Dr. P. Bala Shanmuga Devi were very powerful boosters for the teachers who are real facilitators in nation building. The visits to laboratories of Computer Science, Physics, Zoology, Chemistry and Herbal garden widened the horizon of the participants towards innovation and creativity. The group presentations provided a platform for peer and collaborative learning along-with the exchange of innovative ideas amongst the participants. The Diverse aspects of science education covered in the programme on the whole are expected to promote professional development of teachers.

The training program successfully concluded on August 24, 2022 with the valedictory function. Dr.H.Kohila Subathra Christy, Programme Coordinator, Head and Assistant Professor of Chemistry welcomed the gathering and Dr. P. Bala Shanmuga Devi, Principal, A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women delivered the presidential address. The Valedictory function, chaired by Mr. K. Balathandayuthapani, CEO, Thoothukudi and Mr.M. Muniasamy, Assistant District Project Coordinator and Mrs. N. Persiyal Gnanamani, Assistant Project Officer were the special invitees. The entire team of A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women involved in the activity have also attended the function. In his concluding remarks, Mr. K. Balathandayuthapani, CEO, Thoothukudi impressed upon the importance of the applications of the concepts and strategies learnt from the programme participants in classroom situations. He further expressed his willingness to extend every kind of support and urged the teachers to have a very free interaction with the resource persons of the training programme for all sorts of relevant issues.

During the Valedictory Session, a book "Basic Science" releasing ceremony was held to grace all the resource persons who contributed the chapters and as a mark of their gratitude for participating in this In-Service Training. Report

The APCian Alumnae Association of A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi organised an Educational Exhibition on the topic "Arts and Science Gallery" for school students of IX to XII standard on 30th August 2022 in the college campus with the aim of promoting creativity and learning skills among college students and for imparting knowledge to school students. The exhibition was inaugurated by Dr. S. Banumathi, Head and Associate Professor, P.G and Research Department of Tamil in the august presence of respected Principal, Dr. P. Bala Shunmuga Devi at 10.00 a.m. The students of 13 departments, arts and science, prepared models related to their disciplines exhibited in halls allotted to each department. 34 halls were allotted to the departments. Each hall revealed the team work of students who by means of their exhibits and presentation inspired and shared their expertise to the school students.

The Department of English showcased different literary figures and genres like Gothic literature exhibit, Harry Potter themed exhibit of fantasy literature and Shakespeare exhibits. 




