GENERAL OBSERVATIONS:

- 1. Curriculum Design: The academic programmes offered by the College fulfill the prerequisites for the students to encounter the requirements of the Society/ Industries. The curriculum of the academic programmes, accordingly integrate desired inputs to ensure employability, entrepreneurship and skill development. The curriculum of each programme is designed with core courses, elective courses andnon-major elective courses. The curriculum addresses the human values, environmental conservation and professional ethics. Educational Field visit, Industrial visit, Experiments has been made integral part of the curriculum.
- 2. Teaching Methodologies: Teaching methodologies, including chalk and talk, assignments, role playpower point presentations, YouTube videos are practiced by the faculties. ICT based teaching methods using Microsoft teams, Zoom meet, Google classroom and Kahoot promotecooperative and participative learning experiences. Assessment practices like Short quizzes, Student interviews, Mind maps, Flow charts and Collection of objects improves the learning skill of the students. Above 85% of resultsobserved in all the Departments.
- 3. Research Activities: The institution collaborates with Industries and Universities for establishing Research and Development programs. The institution supports faculty training and support programs, research centers, recognition of research production, encouragement of faculty collaboration, balanced teaching and research responsibilities. The institution encourages the students by giving research scholarships, awards for the innovative ideas and incentives for the faculty who published research article in Scopus indexed journals.
- 4. Infrastructure: Each Department of the Institute is of adequate size and has enough lighting, air ventilation and good ambience. The institution has sufficient number of well-furnished, well ventilated, spacious classrooms and laboratories for conducting theory and practical classes. The institution is highly equipped for sports, games and cultural activities. The library is fully automated with leading library management software MAHALIB which gives a user-friendly interface for searching resources in the library. Solar energy is utilized for V.P. Ulagammal Block.

- 5. Student Support Services: The college provides student support services such as academic counselling, tutoring, mentorship, and career planning assistance. The college provides endowment scholarships to the students with single parents. The campus offers yoga classes, in-house sports and personal counselling variety of disabilities including physical, psychological, and learning disabilities. The student union is made up of students to protect the rights of students. The college cultural committee encourages the students to participate various inter and intra collegiate cultural activities. The college offers professional coaching classes for Bank exam, SET, JRF, Civil Service, etc., in all programmes is sufficient.
- 6. Faculty Development Initiatives: The Institution provides fund and seed money to faculty members for professional development. It includes preparatory training in the form of workshops, seminars and webinars on the relevant pedagogical approaches necessary to effectively teach their content expertise. The college encourages the faculties to complete mandatory training programs, Participation in mentoring programs as a mentor or mentee, participation as a chair of a study section, peer review activities and writing and administering grants.

- Efforts are to be taken for cent percent results in all the courses.
- Future skills and industry trends should be identified to develop competent skills among the students.
