Career Guidance and Placement Cell began its activities with the commencement of Value Added courses from June 2018 to May 2018 in the odd semester and from December 2018 to March 2019 in the even semester. Value added courses offered to all the II and III UG students from 1.00 p.m to 2.00 p.m are:

- Spoken English
- Spoken Hindi
- Coaching for Competitive Examinations
- Jewellery Making
- Aari Work
- Hand Work
- Personal Grooming &
- Tailoring

These add on courses are handled by experts from inside and outside the college.

Skill Development Programme was conducted by Thoothukudi District Employment Exchange July 2018 in the Auditorium. Mr.Prasanth, IAS, Sub-Collector was the chief guest and all the UG Science students attended the programme. Exhibition was conducted in the Open Auditorium on August 13th 2018 in which students exhibited the jewellery items, handmade products and chudhithar tops made by them. Exhibition cum sale was organized by the Cell from 5th October to 7th October 2018 during the Traditional Featival. 45 students exhibited and sold

jewels, handmade key chains, woollen shawls, purses, wall hangings and chudhithar tops made by them. Another exhibition cum sale was organized by the Cell from 10th January to 12th January 2019 in which 35 students exhibited and sold jewels, handmade key chains, woollen shawls, purses, wall hangings and chudhithar tops made by them.
