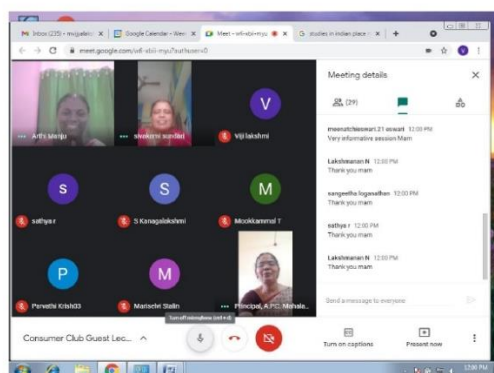

**Guest Lecture on “Cybercrime and Cyber Security” (10.5.2021)**





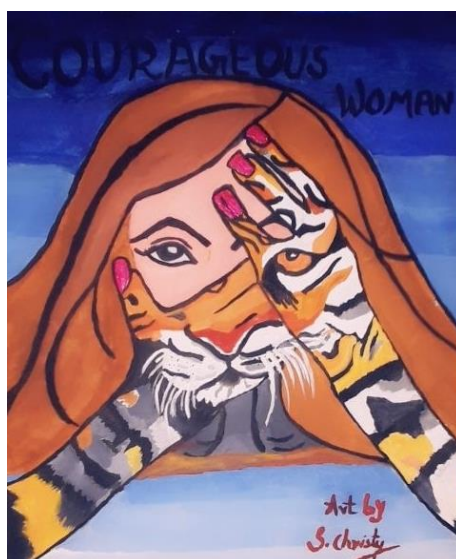


PG & Research Department of Commerce and Tailoring unit has arranged workshop on 06.03.2021 through online platform (MS TEAM) at 10.00,am .
