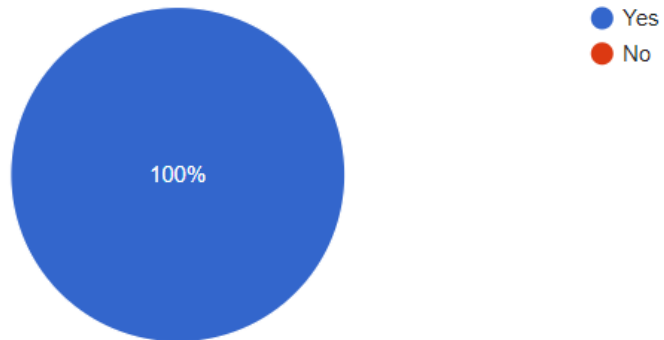

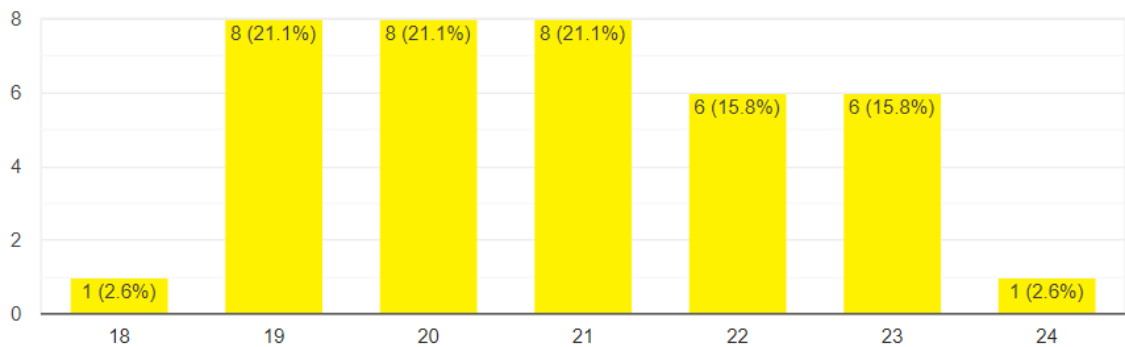
The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) has been conducted through online with the questionnaire recommended by NAAC to upgrade the quality in higher education.

The responses given by the students for the questionnaire are given below:

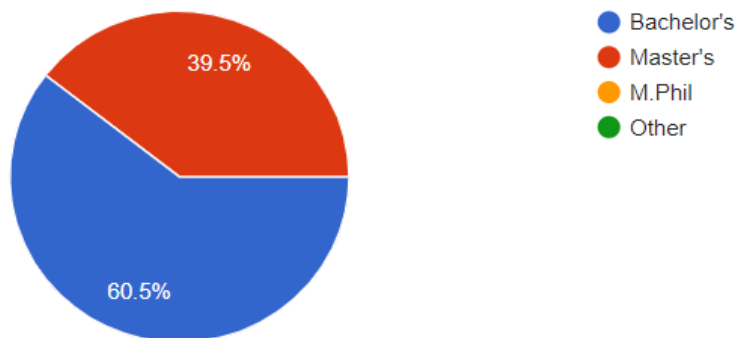

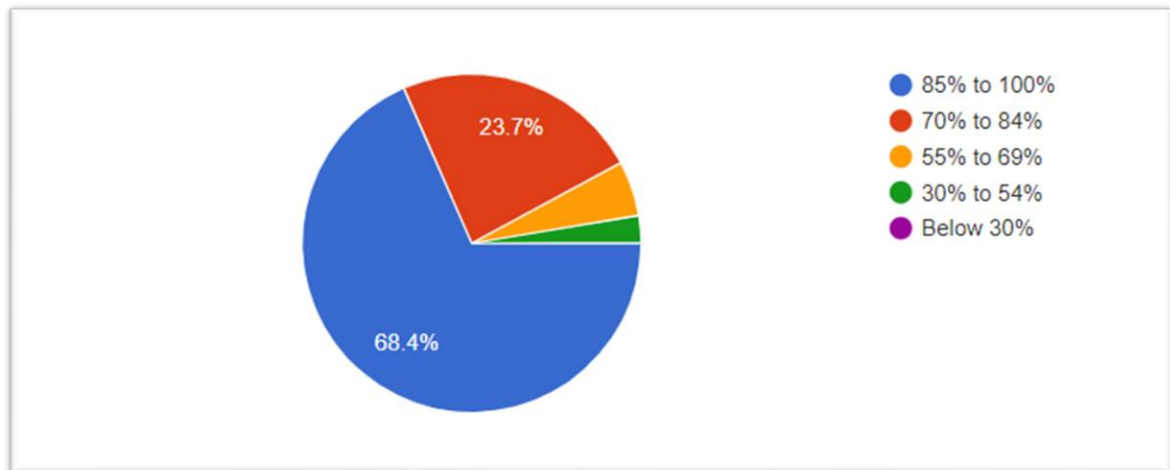

What degree programme are you pursuing now?



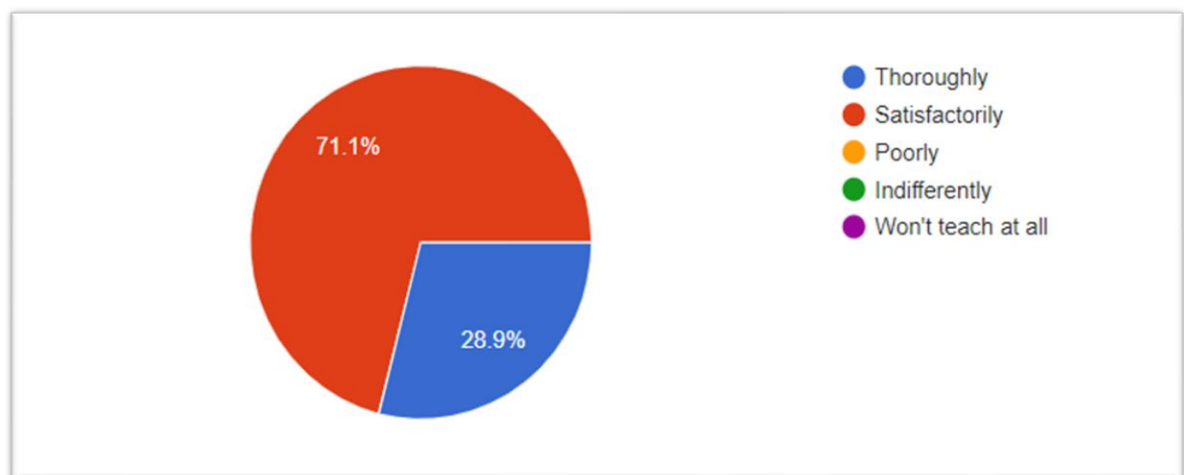
1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

92% of students satisfied that majority of the syllabus were covered in the classroom and the remaining syllabus were covered through online teaching platform during the Lockdown period.

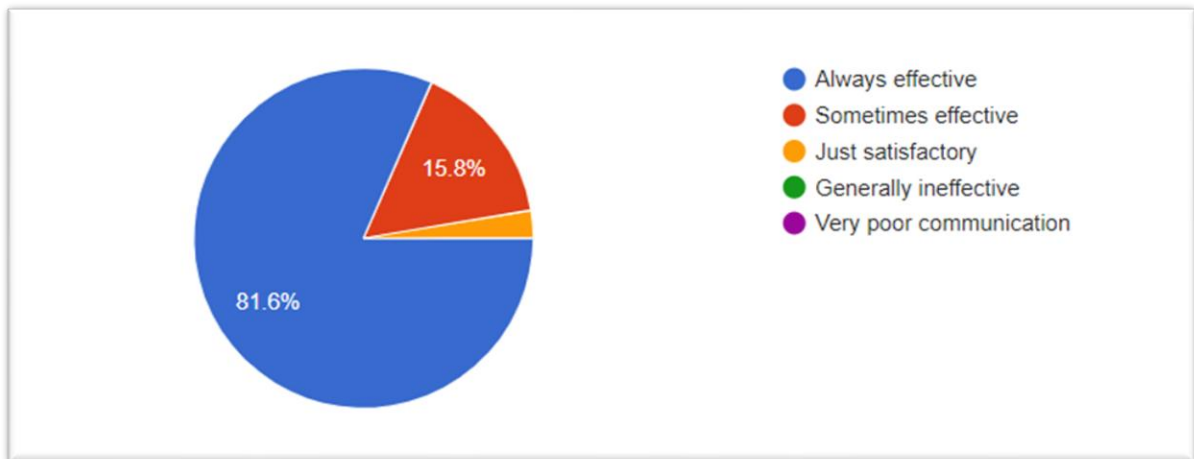
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

100% of students appreciated the preparedness of teachers with the remark “thoroughly & satisfactorily” for the classes.

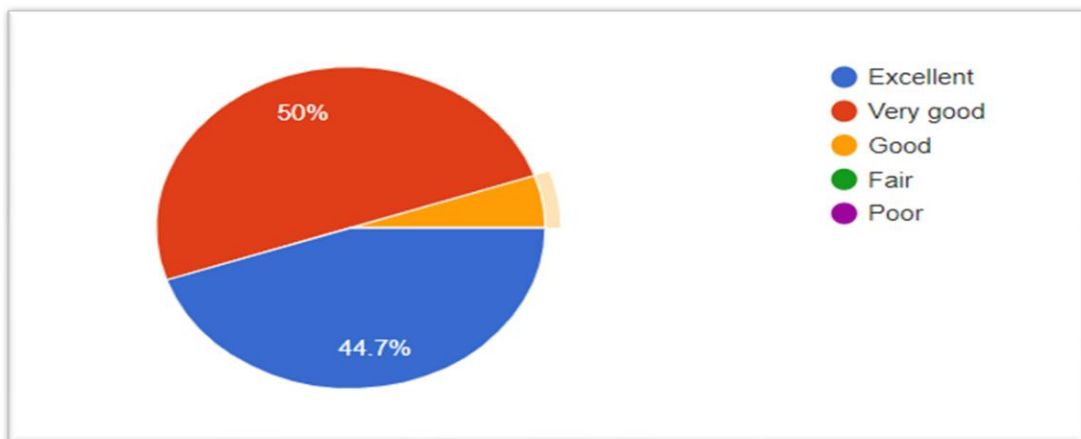
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

97% of students acknowledged that the teachers communicate effectively.

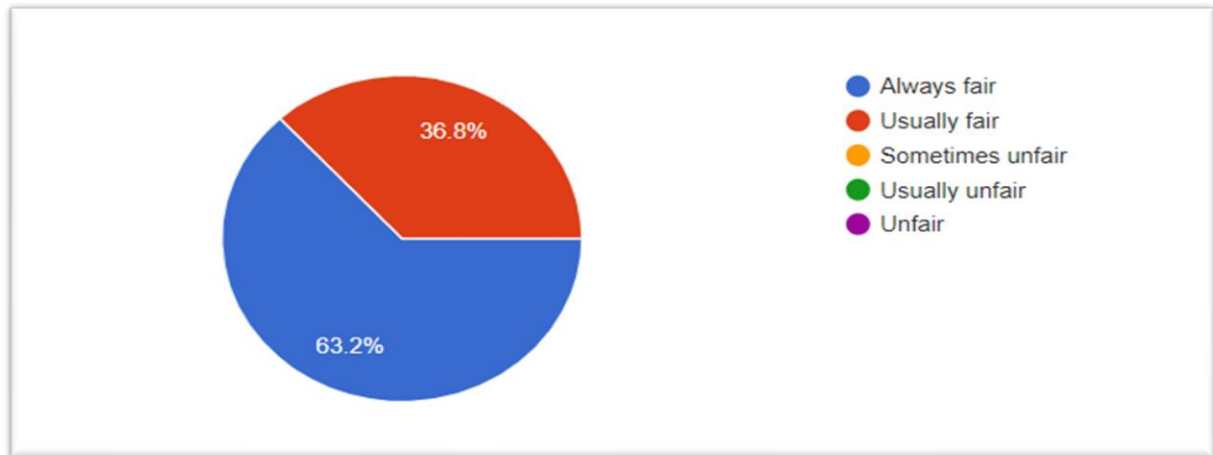
4. The teachers' approach to teaching can best be described as

98% of students admitted that the teachers' approach to teaching is "Very well".

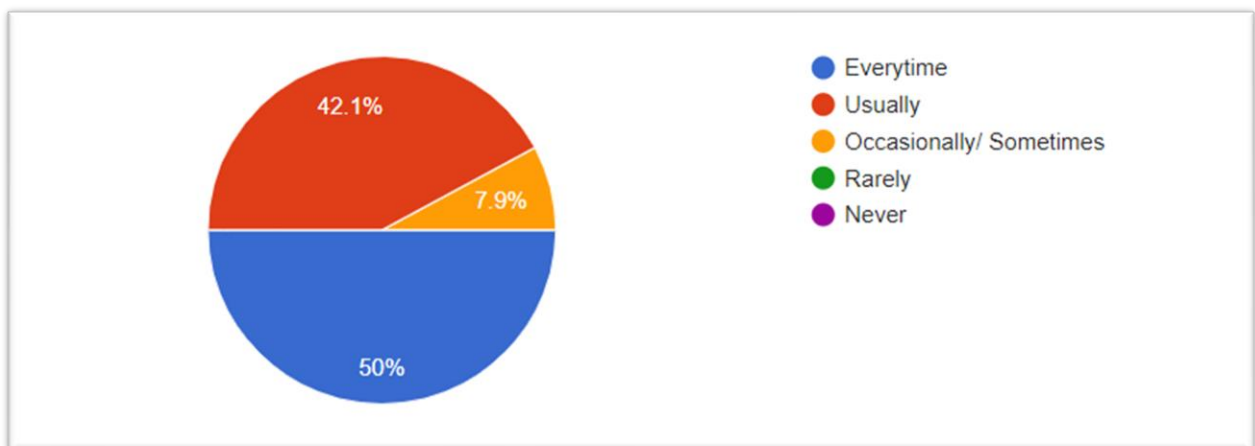
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers

100% of students agreed that the internal evaluation process by the teacher is always fair enough.

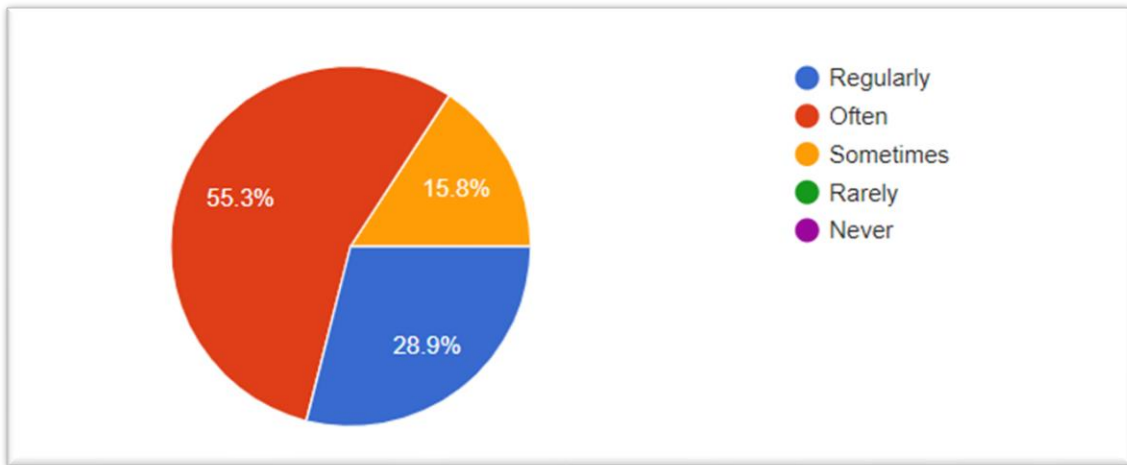
6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?

92% of students remarked that their performance in the assignments get discussed by the teacher in majority times.

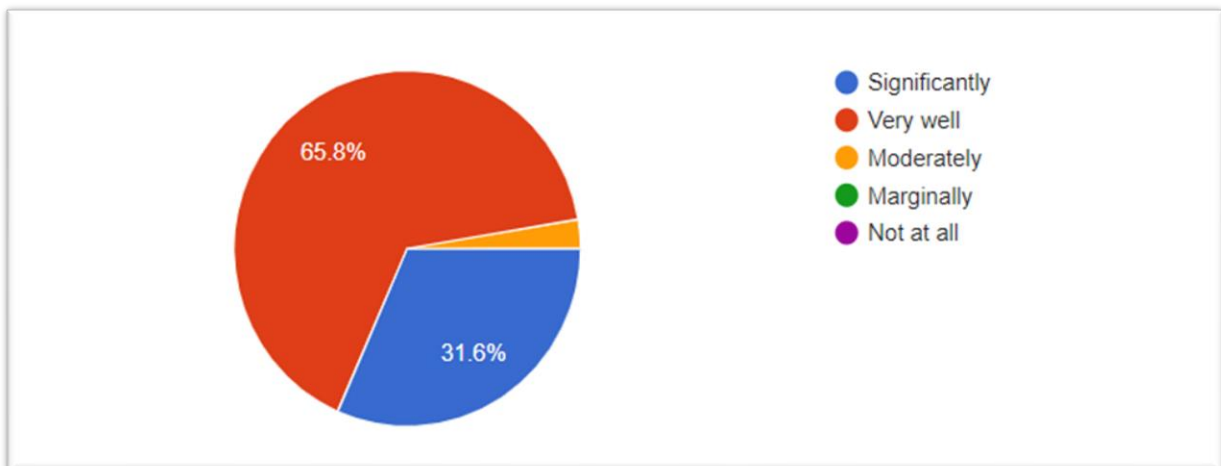
7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.

84% of students believed that the institute takes initiative in promoting internships, student exchange & field visits opportunities for the welfare of the students.

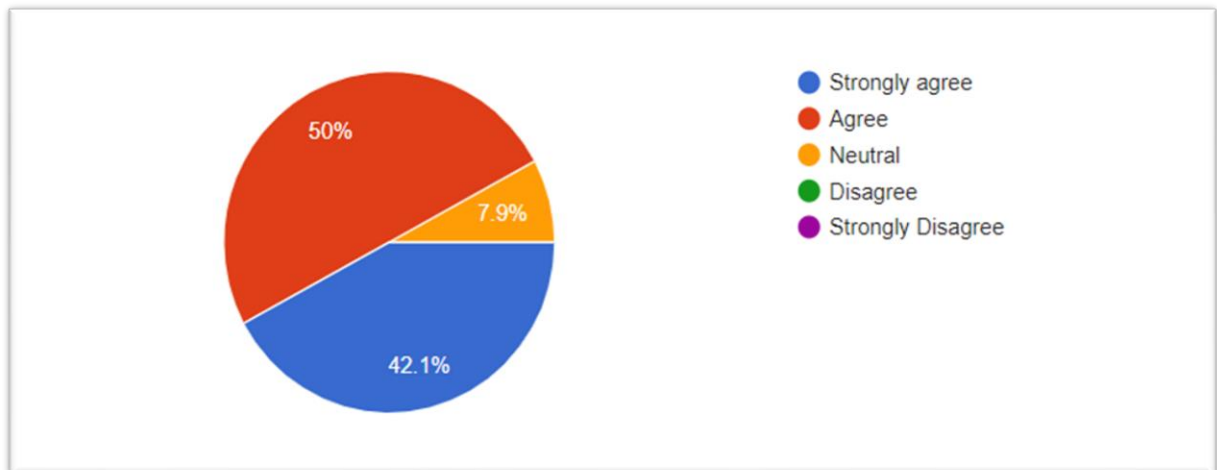
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

97% of students believed that the teaching & mentoring process in the institute facilitates them in their cognitive, social and emotional growth.

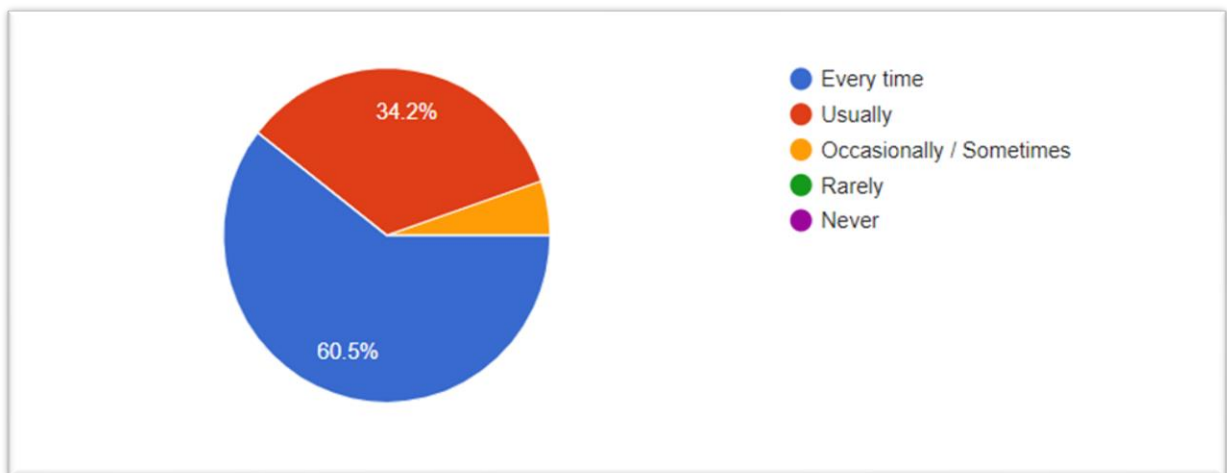
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow

92% of students believed that multiple opportunities were provided by the institution to upgrade the process of learn and grow.

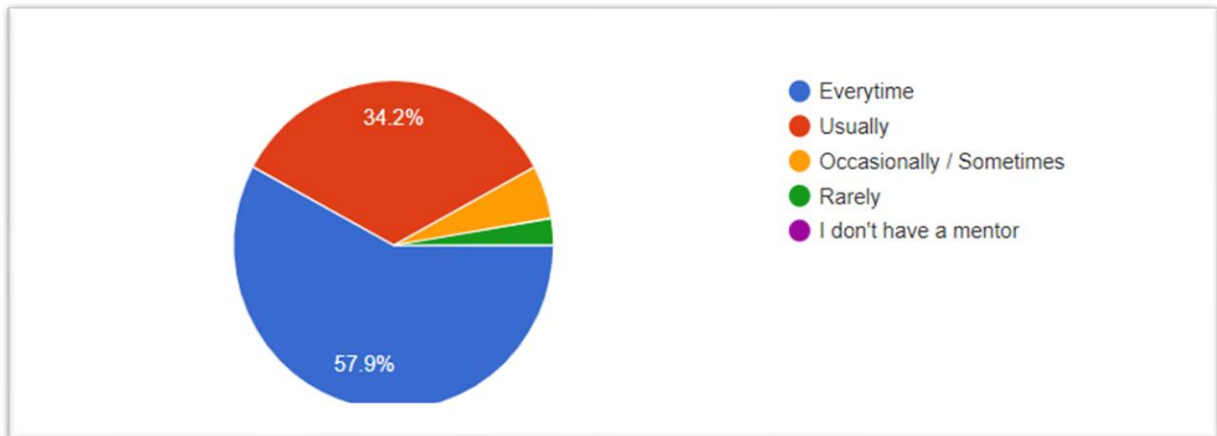
10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes

95% of students believed that the teachers informed them about their expected competencies, course outcomes and program outcomes in majority times.

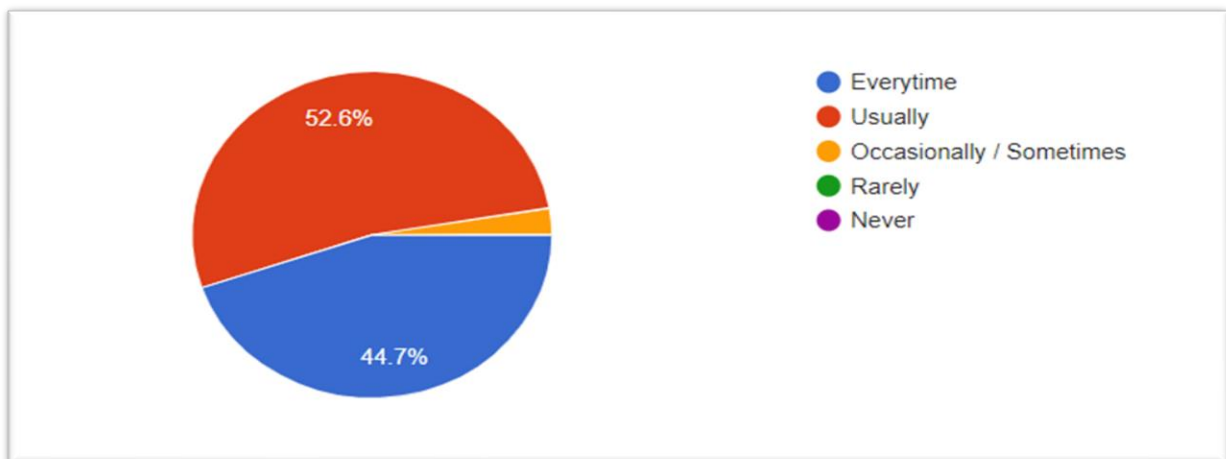
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you

92% of students believed that time to time their mentor took necessary follow-up with an assigned task.

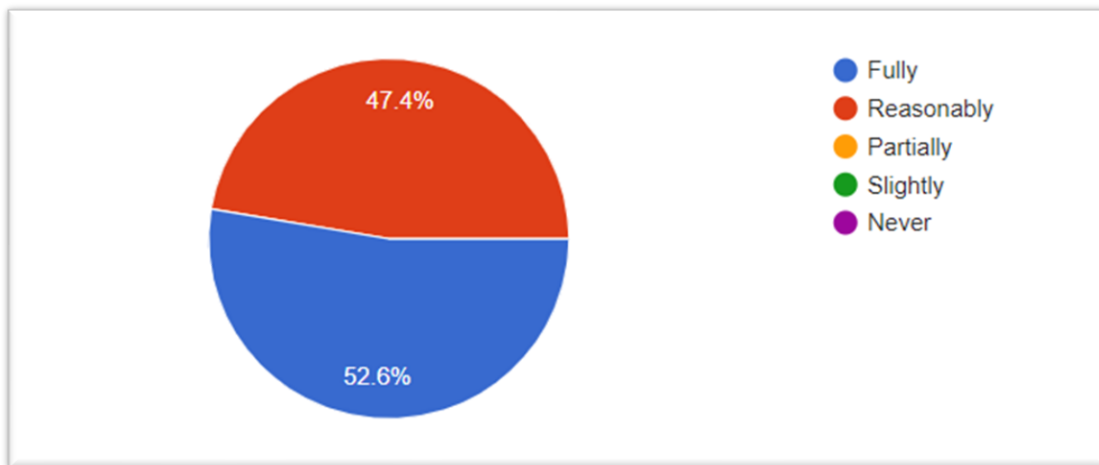
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications

97% of students believed that while teaching the teacher illustrated the concepts through examples and applications.

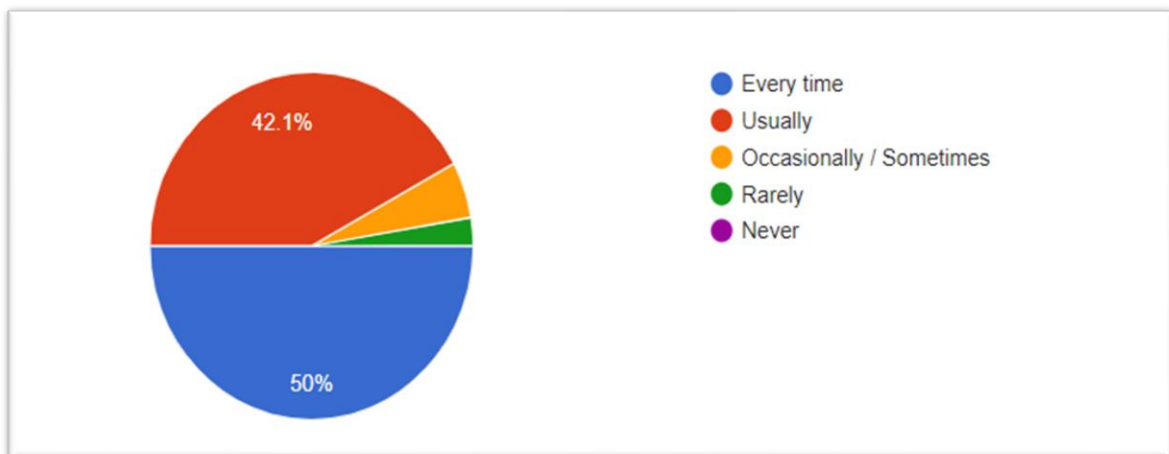
13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges

100% of students believed that teachers always identifying their strengths and encouraged them to face the challenges with the proper guidelines.

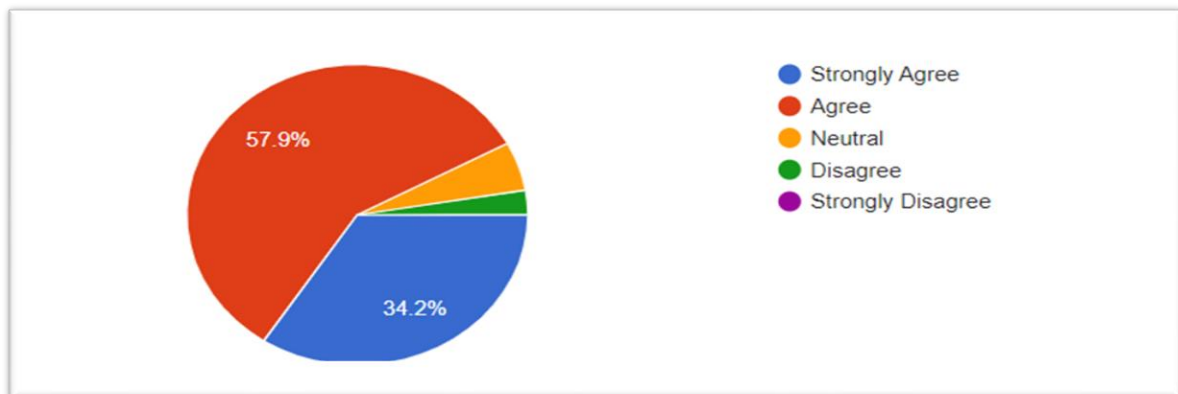
14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them

92% of students believed that the teachers always able to identify their weaknesses and helped them to overcome it.

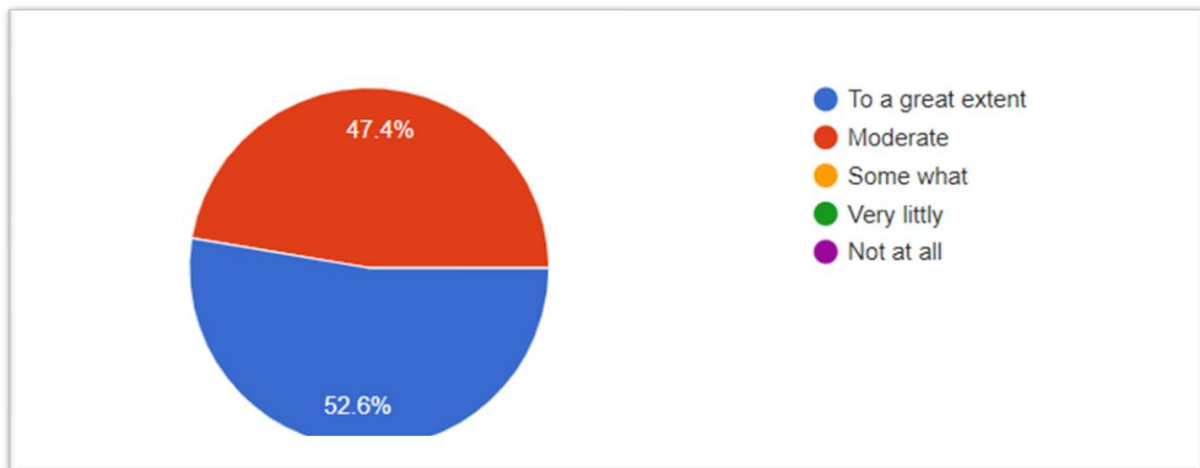
15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, reviewing and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process

92% of students agreed that the institute makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.

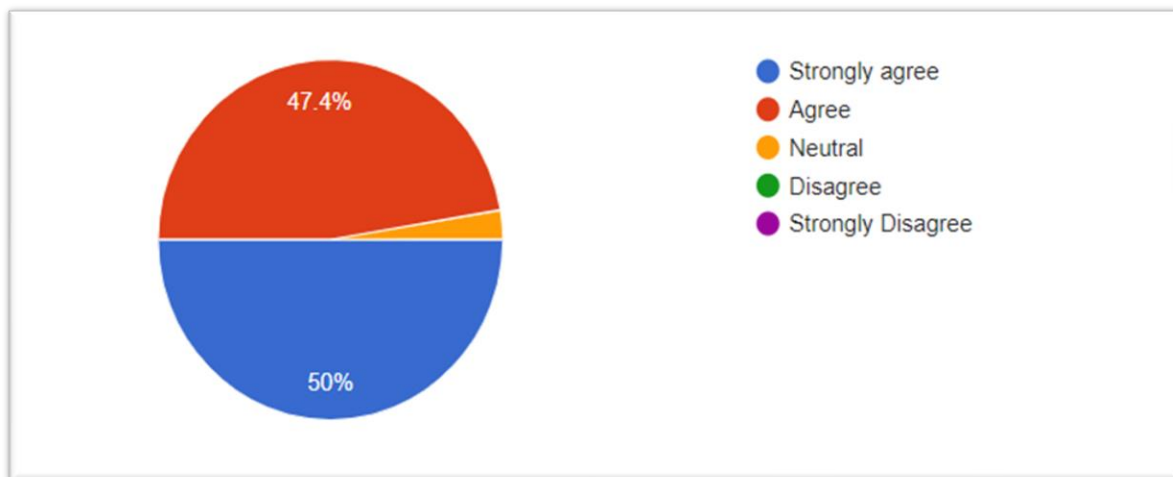
16. The institute / teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences

100% of students agreed that institution/teachers use student centric methods for enhancing learning experiences.

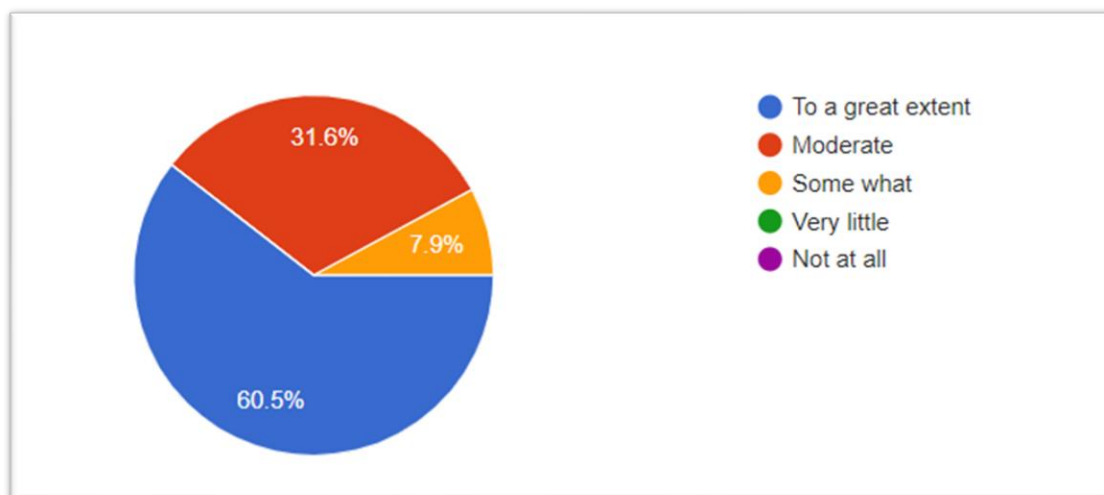
17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities

97% of students agreed that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities through online during the pandemic time.

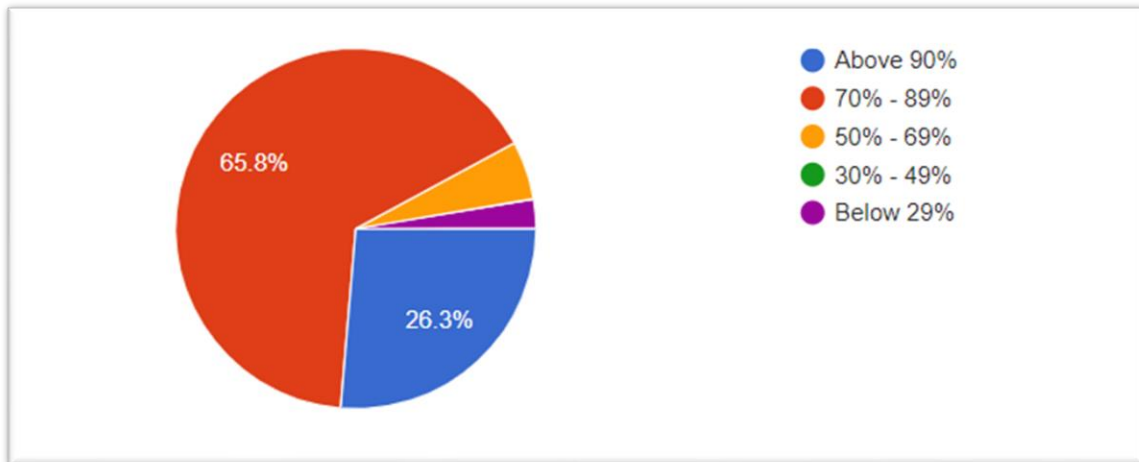
18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work

92% of students agreed that institute/ teachers take efforts to inculcate soft skills and employability skills to make them ready for the world of work.

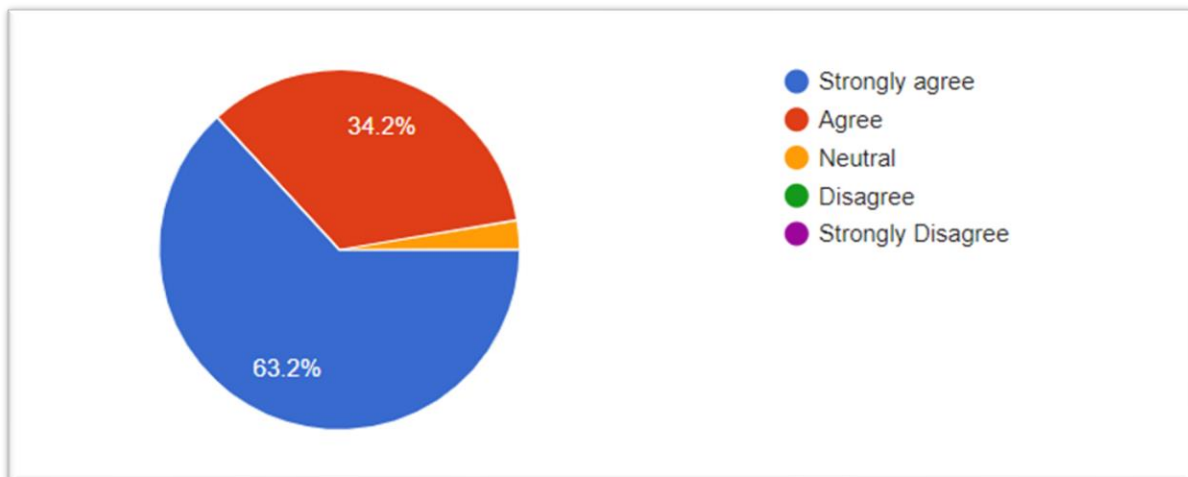
19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching?
