
AP.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi Department of Commerce (Aided)


2021-2022





Mrs.Janci gave a motivational presentation as to how the students should adapt themselves to this digital learning environment, efforts to be taken by the students and steps already taken by the government and teachers to minimise digital divide. She also insisted the students to use mobile phones and laptops only for education and also, to minimise the inequality in providing education to all, the students should use other learning resources like books and library. 62 students of I B.Com and III B.Com attended the programme and were inspired and motivated by the speech of the Guest Speaker.






She gave an understandable presentation about research, need for research, steps involved in research, types of research, and thrust areas in which research can be conducted by commerce students. Hands on training was given by the resource person on application of statistical tools like correlation, regression and chi square test by using Excel. Finally, Dr.Rajeswari explained the points to be considered to prepare a good research report. 38 students of III B.Com and 58 students of I B.Com (Totally 96 students) attended the programme and got benefitted.








Mr.M.Siva Baarathi, Field Coordinator, TN-EDII, Anna University Regional Campus, Tirunelveli was the Resource Person. Mr.Siva Baarathi gave a presentation about the important areas in which entrepreneurship and innovations can be introduced, that is, Manufacturing Sector, Service Sector, Farming and Trading. He explained about various schemes of Government like PMEGP, UYEGP, NEEDS and about the role of DIC, DII, MSME, MHRD's IIC and TN-EDII and so on to promote entrepreneurship and innovation almost in all the fields. 95 students and faculty attended the Workshop and got benefitted.

Mr.Rajkumar gave an excellent lecture about the importance of entrepreneurship and role played by the entrepreneurs in generating employment opportunities and in the development of country's economy. He gave a detailed explanation about various schemes of the government to support MSME, loans and subsidy that can be availed under various schemes, training institutes that mold the skills of young entrepreneurs and to enable new entrepreneurs to prepare project proposal. 149 students of the department of commerce attended the programme and got benefitted. 


