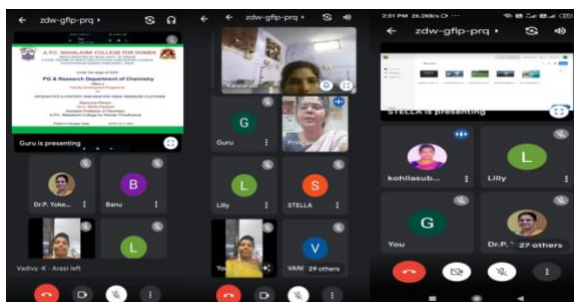
Thoothukudi delivered a talk on IPR Management and start ups. At last Dr. D. Shanmuga Priya delivered a vote of thanks.

Subathra Christy, Head & Assistant Professor of Chemistry. 68 faculties of our college are the beneficiaries.

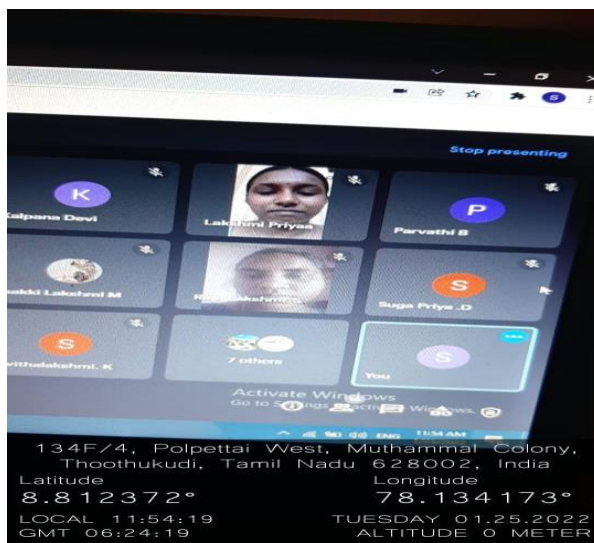
