

A Faculty Development Programme on *How to Use the Smart Board Effectively* was organised by the IQAC on 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2018(27<sup>th</sup> September, 2018). Mr. Aiyadurai and Mr. Gomathinayagam, Assistant Professors of Computer Science, V.O. Chidambaram College, Thoothukudi demonstrated the various applications of the smart board.



Freshers test was given on 28<sup>th</sup> June, 2018, to monitor their entry level competency in language and general knowledge. A detailed student profile was collected from the first year students to identify their social and economic background and their areas of interest.

The Secretary Tmty. C. Subbulakshmi inaugurated the Women Empowerment Cell and the Incubation Centre on 6<sup>th</sup> August, 2018. It was followed by a special address by Mrs. Deepa Pradeep, Chennai. She spoke on Women Empowerment.



Following this programme, a series of awareness programmes on the topics relevant to Gender Sensitivity were organized by the various Clubs and Cells.





A **Mock Peer Team Visit** was conducted on 15<sup>th</sup> December, 2018. Dr. Ramganesh, Department of Educational Technology, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirapalli and Dr. E.
