


## A.P.C. Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi - 2 IQAC REPORT 2019 – 2020



Skype from Malaysia. The participants presented their innovative ideas in the fields of teaching-learning, research, entrepreneurship and marketing.





















Zoom Platform was purchased for the benefit of an unobstructive network of teachers and teaching experience. The faculty made excellent use of the platform and organized many webinars.




