It is my great privilege to present the Annual Report for the academic year, 2021 – 2022.

True to the chosen vision and mission of uplifting the socially marginalized and economically less privileged sections of society, the most respected serving President of our College Management Committee, honourable Shri. A.P.C.V. Chockalingam, has been working tirelessly to help the college evolve into one of the high-ranking institutions. Esteemed Madam Secretary, Smt. Subbulakshmi Chockalingam, has also been greatly instrumental in enabling the college to empower its students with essential education along with the noble ethos and the rich tradition of our culture.

In the academic year 2021- 2022 despite the challenging backdrop of the ongoing COVID-19 situation, our college has demonstrated remarkable resilience and proactiveness. The college has demonstrated a commendable level of academic activity and adaptability. In response to the circumstances, the college swiftly transitioned to online learning modalities, ensuring that academic continuity was maintained without compromising the quality of education. In the April 2021 University Examinations, a 99% pass has been recorded in all the UG & PG programmes, and 11 students have secured university ranks.

Faculty have demonstrated excellence in both teaching and research. They have participated in 96 International, 175 National, and 26 State-level seminars and

have presented papers in 100 International and 7 national conferences. They have also published research articles in 122 International journals and published 26 books. Also, the college organized 12 Faculty Development Programmes for teaching staff and 6 programmes for non-teaching staff. 96 teaching and 22 non – teaching faculty have attended Faculty Development programmes during the academic year. Three faculty have attended Refresher Courses and three others, Orientation Programmes. Dr.M.Nagamalar, Assistant Professor of H.R.M, SDNB Vaishnav College for Women, Chrompet, Chennai was the Resource Person. Participants gained in-depth knowledge about the basic concepts of IPR, Patent Act, types of intellectual properties with innovations in India like Volcano Levitating Bluetooth Speaker, self-adhesive and biodegradable strip to detect blood sugar, smart lock, and smart bench. 92 faculty attended the programme.
- Alumnae Meet and Guest Lecture was conducted by the Department on 15th August, 2021 in Google Meet.
