With immense pleasure, we present you an overview of our institution's endeavours, accomplishments, and future aspirations over the past year. As we reflect on the past year, I am proud to showcase the progress of our college. The college offers 10 Aided Programmes, 10 Unaided Programmes, and 5 Research programmes. With the 653 freshers the academic year 2022 – 2023 commenced with the Student Council Election followed by the inauguration of the Student Council with the elected office bearers.

Our students have demonstrated excellence in the April 2022 examination. The college has a pass percentage of 93 percent in the April 2022 examinations. We are extremely proud to announce that 19 of our students have excelled by securing University Ranks.

In the National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF), our college has secured a place in the Rank Band I. We have been ranked as the college with the 2nd lowest fee structure college in Arts and Commerce and 6th lowest fee structure college in Science college by the India Today MDRF Best Colleges Ranking 2023.

To stay updated with the latest trends, research and teaching methodology our faculties attend Refresher Course and Faculty Development Programme for professional development. Dr. B. Abinaya Bharathi, Assistant Professor of English, Ms. J. Vasantha Sena, Assistant Professor of English, Mrs. R. Anista, Physical Education Director attended the refresher course this year. Our college has organized 3 Faculty Development

Programmes for the Teaching Staff and 2 Faculty Development Programmes for the Non-Teaching Staff. In total, 97 teaching and 31 non teaching faculty have attended various Faculty Development Programmes. Out of them, fourteen faculty have attended Refresher Courses.

To enhance research our college research forum organised a programme on Integrity in Research and Nuances of Project Writing. An International conference on Applied Mathematics and Intellectual Property Rights ICAMIPR3 – 2022 was organized by the Department of Mathematics.

The resource person was assisted by Dr.A.antony Selva Priya, Assistant Professor of our Department to guide the students in applying various functions of MS-Excel. Dr.V. Sornaganesh trained the students on t- Test, ANOVA, Correlation and Regression techniques used for data analysis. 57 III B.Com students attended the workshop. Since hands on training was given, it was very easier for the students to apply all the tools, short cut keys, formatting mathematical, and statistical tools and gave positive feedback about the workshop,

Mahalaxmi College for Women, Thoothukudi organised an Educational Exhibition on the topic “Arts and Science Gallery” for school students of IX to XII standard on 30th August 2022 in the college campus with the aim of promoting creativity and learning skills among college students and for imparting knowledge to school students. - International Literacy Day was commemorated on 22nd September 2022 by the Department of Commerce (Aided) at 6.00 p.m in Google Meet on the topic “Transforming Literacy Learning Spaces”. Dr.M.Nagamalar, Assistant Professor, PG Department of HRM, SDNB Vaishnav College for Women, Chrompet, Chennai was the Resource Person and she started her presentation by briefing about UNESCO and its initiatives to reduce poverty and to

promote literacy across the globe. Dr.Nagamalar explained different types of literacy apart from general education, like digital literacy, financial literacy, media literacy and cultural literacy which are needed to eradicate poverty and inequality. 92 students attended the webinar and gained knowledge about the different types of literacy with their significance in a person's life in reducing poverty and raising the standard of living of people.

It was a new teaching and learning experience to both the faculty and the students.
