Raja Mohan (PC & AL) and in the seminar hall building where an orientation of industry was given about the history of the industry. It was great to know that industry follows conservation of environment, social services, education, Award for the employees and conscious about clean and green.

After introduction all students were brought to visit plant to understand how production is carried out in company and how company reaches their customer. The organization is primarily responsible for production of Heavy water (D₂O) (from normal water) which is used as a Moderator and coolant in nuclear reactor.HWP consists of two plants i) solvent production plant ii) solvent extraction plant. HWP has entrusted with development and deployment of technology for separation of rare materials from phosphoric acid and production of solvents. The product from this plant will be sent to other DAE units for further separation and refining and will be finally utilized for Indian nuclear program.
